THENCE following an existing fence along the South line of said Kainer property, S 89° 48° 16" E a distance of 3569.71 feet to a capped 3/8" iron rod set at a fence corner for the Southeast corner of said Kainer property and for the Northeast corner of the herein described tract, also being on the West line of the Charlie Wanjura tract as described in Volume 760, Page 829, Fayette County Deed Records, Volume 471, Page 326, Colorado County Deed Records and Volume 323, Page 842, Colorado County Deed Records:

THENCE along the common line between this tract and said Thuemler residual tract, the following calls:

- N 89* 47* 50" W 1571.74 feet to a 2" pipe corner post found on the East line of Sedan Road for the Northwest corner of said Thuemler residual tract and for an exterior ell corner of the herein described tract:
