

Beauty on the Boulder








LOCATION:

BEAUTY ON THE BOULDER: Located approximately 30 miles south of Big Timber, Montana.

BIG TIMBER: Located at the confluence of the Yellowstone and Boulder River, Big Timber is the Sweet Grass County seat and services as the support system to the areas cattle ranching community and recreation industry. Big Timber features a school system which offers K-12, a hospital, clinic, nursing home, Assisted Living, dentist, beauty shops, a quilt shop, golf course, churches, grocery and clothing stores, museums, art galleries, establishments offering fine food from the nationally acclaimed dining at "The Grand Hotel", to casual meals at the Frosty Freez, motels, bed and breakfasts, movie theater and a paved airport capable of facilitating most any private aircraft.

BILLINGS: Located 110 miles to the east, Billings is the center of Montana's livestock industry. The International Airport in Billings is presently serviced by 5 majors airlines. Billings has two of the finest medical facilities in the northwest. Shopping, fine dining, theater and the arts make Billings the true hub of Montana.
