Committees in Hide-A-Way Hills are the backbone of the community. They volunteer countless hours to make their community a better place in which to live and play.

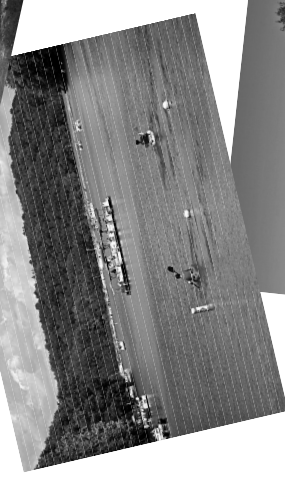
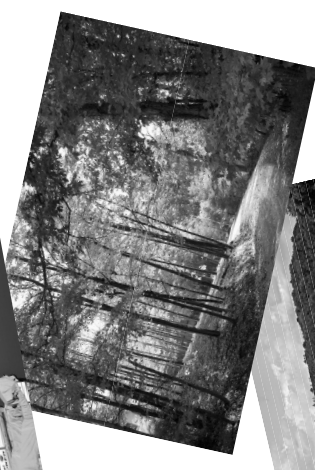
The Club office is located in the lower level of the Lodge. Contact the Club office for specifics on monthly and annual assessment fees.

From Columbus go toward Lancaster on Rt. 33. Take the bypass to the Tarkiln/Horns Mill Road exit. Turn left off the exit to the stop light which is Business Rt. 33. Continue across Business Rt. 33 where Tarkiln Road turns into Horns Mill Rd.

From Athens go toward Lancaster on Route 33. Take Business Route 33 to the stop light at Tarkiln/Horns Mill Road. Turn right onto Horns Mill Road.

From either direction, proceed east on Horns Mill Road, which then turns into Hide-A-Way Hills Road, for 7 miles to the entrance of HAH.

Hide-A-Way Hills Club is a 1,654

acre private resort community located near southeast Ohio's Hocking Hills. Our facilities include:

Security

A 24-hour Security staff, one of our most valuable amenities, secures the entrances of Hide-A-Way Hills, welcomes guests, patrols 31 miles of roads, and makes house security checks for absent homeowners. It is their function to enforce the rules of Hide-A-Way Hills for the protection of the members, and the members enjoyment of the facilities.

Airport

We have a daylight only, turf/grass landing strip with visual flight rules only. Tie downs are available. Specs are 2350' long by 100' wide with an elevation of 775'.

Barn & Stables

A limited number of stalls are available at the barn. Members must maintain and feed their own horses. A riding ring is located across the road from the barn.

Beach

A sandy beach is located at the end of the southwest cove on the Lake of the Four Seasons. In addition to being a great place to cool off in the summer, the beach offers a picnic area and docks for boaters who want to bring their crew in for a swim or a bit of sunbathing on the sand.



Chapel in the Pines

Located near the Lodge, our Chapel offers an inspirational setting for non-denominational worship on Sundays from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. During inclement weather, services are held in the Lodge Great Room.

A Catholic mass is celebrated on the last Sunday of the month.

Golf Course & Clubhouse

Our challenging 9-hole course begins and ends at the Clubhouse where members and guests enjoy a limited menu with legal beverages year 'round. Along with men's, women's and mixed leagues, many golf tournaments and scrambles are scheduled during the season.

Guests must pay a nominal fee to play. Most members use their own golf carts; a limited number are available to rent.



Playground & Basketball Court

Located near the Shelter House by the front entrance, the playground provides sturdy play equipment designed for the safety of the children (new in 2008).

A bike path designed for tricycles, bikes and roller skates encircles the play area with benches provided for all "watchers".

There's also a paved basketball court.

Shelter House

Located near the front entrance close to the playground and the south docks, the Shelter House is always busy with some kind of activity. Picnic tables and electric are provided. Members may rent the Shelter House for family reunions, family picnics and other member-related activities.

Shooting Range

The range is available to all members and guests. For the safety of our members, a Range Officer must be present at all shoots. Times must be reserved with a Range Officer of the Shooting Committee.

Swimming Pool & Tennis Court

Two tennis courts and a practice board are located next to the swimming pool. The courts are lighted for evening play. The swimming pool is open from Memorial Day through Labor Day, with lifeguards on duty.



Lakes, Boating & Fishing

Power boating is permitted on the Lake of the Four Seasons, limited to member-owned boats only. Rowing, canoeing and fishing are permitted on all our well-stocked lakes. Boats must be registered annually at the club office and receive a boat decal before launching. A limited number of docks are available at no cost to members.

Off Road Course

Located near the Airport, the dirt track has been developed for all-terrain vehicles. The mile long track includes jumps and turns for the ATV enthusiasts. All ATV's must be member owned and have their lot number on the vehicle.
