### On-Site Riverfront Marina

For those with a passion for boating and fishing, the scenic Sea Oaks Marina is built along the banks of the Indian River. Located between the Fort Pierce and Sebastian inlets, the marina has easy access to the Intracoastal Waterway and the Atlantic Ocean where you can enjoy canoeing, kayaking, sailing and motor boating. The secured 48-slip marina accommodates vessels up to 40 feet; each slip is equipped with power, water and storage. Sea Oaks Yacht Club belongs to the Yachting Club of America with its reciprocal privileges.









### Outdoor Enthusiast's Dream

The Indian River Lagoon is one of the most biologically diverse ecosystems in the continental United States. Experience some of the best fishing the Treasure Coast has to offer on the waters of the lagoon and the many close-by inland lakes.

The Historic Jungle Trail runs along the western boarder of Sea Oaks. The seven-and-a-half miles of nature trail is part of the Indian River Lagoon Scenic Highway System. This picturesque path is perfect for walking, jogging or biking along the Indian River.

If you enjoy cycling, the 38 mile low-traffic bike lane along State Route A1A borders Sea Oaks.

Sea Oaks golfers enjoy, in cooperation with a local course, activities that include standing tee times, league play, as well as various golf groupings and clinics. Special events are scheduled throughout the season.





### Nature Lover's Paradise



The natural beauty of the area impresses all who visit. The majestic oaks gracing the boulevard provide a welcoming canopy, and varieties of shrubs and exquisite flowers can be found in bloom throughout the year. Shelling on the beach at low tide is a popular activity; here, too, are some of the nation's most significant nesting grounds for sea turtles. Manatees and dolphins can be spotted in the nearby lagoon. And birdlife abounds, with snowy egrets, frigate birds, spoonbills, white pelicans and herons common sights.













Situated on the oceanfront are luxurious low-rise condominiums and villas featuring spacious floor plans and wraparound terraces that embrace the sea and sky. These residences afford spectacular, sweeping views and sounds of the Atlantic Ocean and are just steps away, over the dunes, to the beach.



Riverfront Villas
