

Being all these certain tracts or parcels of land, a part of the J. S. HERRING SURVEY, Abstract No. 263, Bowie County, Texas, and being described as follows, to-wit:

FIRST TRACT: Being 1/2 acre of land, more or less, described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an old iron stake at the S. E. C. of the 100 acre tract of land now or formerly owned by S. D. Knapp;
THENCE North with the E. B. line of said Knapp tract, 208.3 feet to an iron stake for corner;
THENCE West 104.2 feet to an iron stake at the N. E. C. of a 1/2 acre tract heretofore sold to the Methodist Church for parsonage purposes;
THENCE South with the S. B. line of said Church lot, 208.3 feet to the S. E. C. of same in the South line of the Knapp tract;
THENCE East with the South line of the Knapp tract, 104.2 feet to the place of beginning and containing 1/2 acre of land, more or less.

SECOND TRACT: Being 4.3 acres of land, more or less, described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at an old iron stake at the S. E. C. of a 100 acre tract now or formerly owned by S. D. Knapp, same being the S. E. C. of the above described First Tract;
THENCE North at 208.3 feet, the N. E. C. of the above described First Tract, continuing on 45 feet, in all 253.3 feet to an iron stake at the N. E. C. of the M. B. Chandler lot;
THENCE West with the South line of the Chandler tract, 372 feet to an iron stake for the N. E. C. of this tract;
THENCE South with the West boundary line of a tract now or formerly owned by W. S. Shaver, 490.3 feet to the S. E. C. of a lot deed to D. L. Taylor, an iron stake in the old fence line;
THENCE West with Jacobs North Boundary line, 75 feet to his N. W. C.;
THENCE North 56 feet to a stake in the old fence row;
THENCE West 317 feet to the N. E. B. line of the original Frank Ing Tract;
THENCE North 181 feet to the place of beginning, and containing 4.3 acres of land, more or less.

The above two tracts of land are also described as First and Second Tracts in that certain Deed from Billie Bob White for Willie Holley White, et al, to D. M. White and wife, Billie Bob White, dated December 2nd, 1933, and recorded in Vol. 189, Page 143, Deed Records, Bowie County, Texas, and being all the land owned by the lessor in the said Herring Survey.
