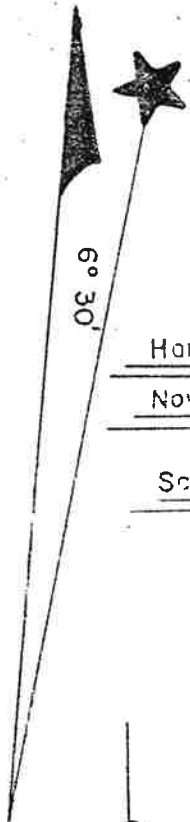

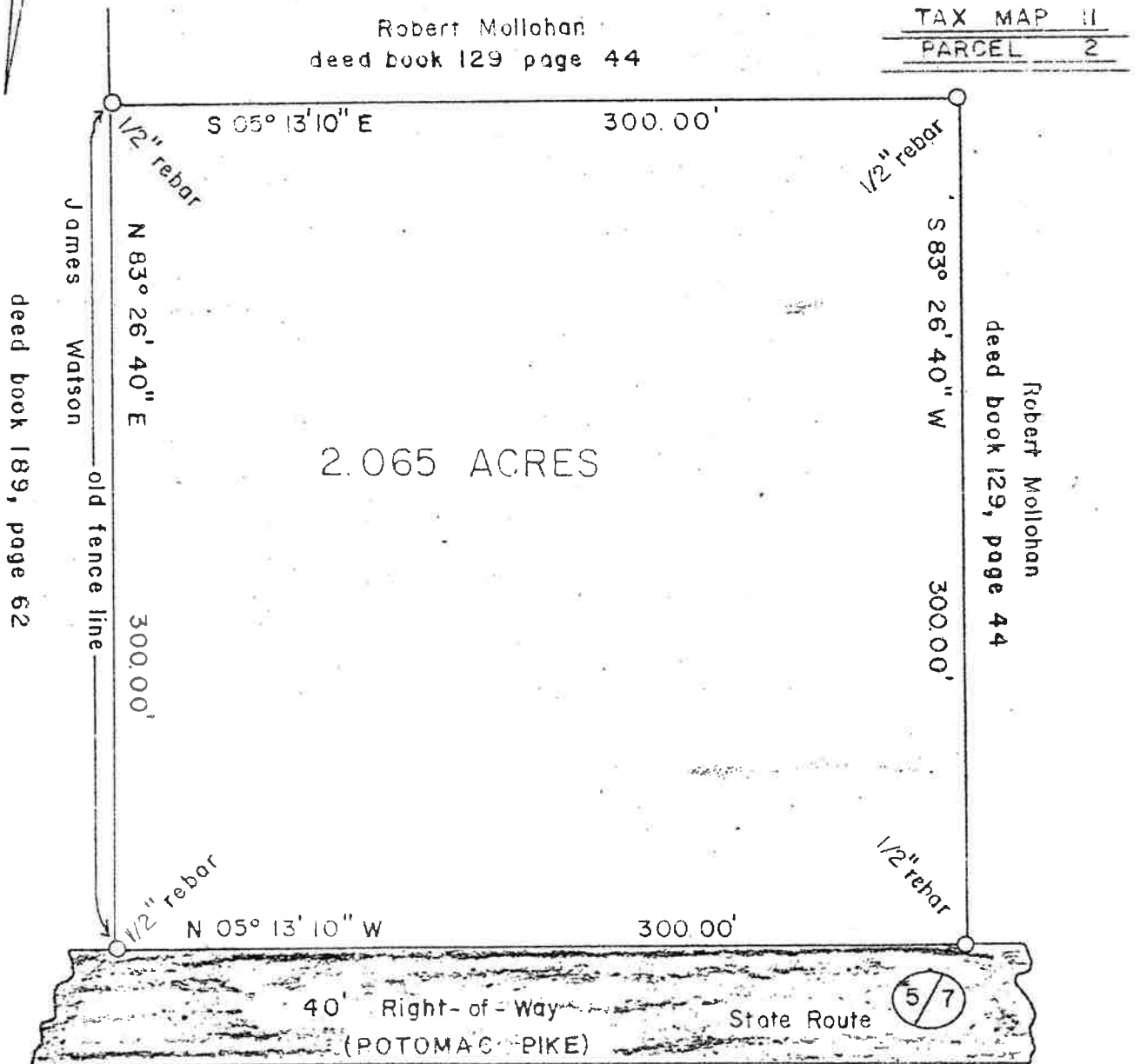


Hampshire Meridian
