LOCATION: The Kent Creek Farm is located in South Central Montana south of Montana's major city, Billings, within Yellowstone County and also within the borders of the Crow Reservation.

ACCESS: The farm can be accessed off of State Highway 418 also known as the Blue Creek/Pryor Creek Road. Followed by a short distance of gravel road to the west to the farm site.

THE BILLINGS AREA: The City of Billings is named after a former President of the Northern Pacific Railroad. With one of the largest trade areas in the United States, Billings is the commodities capital of Montana and the trade and distribution center for most of Montana, Northern Wyoming, and the western portions of North & South Dakota. ELEVATION: Ranges from 1,100-1,200 feet.

CLIMATE: The Kent Creek Farm is in a temperate climate for Montana. Minimal snowfall within the Chinook Belt. Annual rainfall is between 14—16 inches.

WATER: Kent Creek is a year round spring fed stream providing water for a two acre bass pond and also 18 acres of irrigation which flows through the 160 acre farm site.
