LICENSE 6569 (APPLICATION 17077) ESTRELLA CREEK (UNDERFLOW) TRIBUTARY TO SALINAS RIVER IN SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY

As owners of the land that is served under License 6569, you are listed as co-owners of the above water right, each with an undivided interest. In December 2004, Richard Calkins contacted this office and indicated that he was not interested in maintaining the water right. At that time, Mr. Calkins explained that, to his knowledge, water is no longer diverted from Estrella Creek under the license.

In a letter to you, dated December 20, 2004, I discussed several options regarding the ownership of the water right. One option is for all owners of the license to voluntarily request revocation of the water right. If all owners agreed, the Division of Water Rights (Division) would revoke License 6569. All rights and priority to appropriate water under the license would be forfeited and all future liabilities associated with this right would be relieved. However, if one or more owner wished to maintain the water right, any owner who does not use water under the license could assign all of his or her interest in the license to the remaining owner(s).

The Division received a request for revocation of License 6569 from Richard and Joyce Calkins, dated December 24, 2004. On behalf of Fred Oliver, Richard Secher informed this office by telephone conversation (January 20, 2005) that Mr. Oliver is interested in maintaining the water right. Mr. Secher submitted a written statement to this effect, dated January 20, 2005, and requested that all correspondence regarding the water right be directed to him (Mr. Secher). Robert Behlendorf submitted a request for revocation that he signed on January 25, 2005. However, in a telephone conversation on February 25, 2005, Mr. Behlendorf reconsidered and stated that it is his intention to maintain ownership of the water right under License 6569 with Mr. Oliver.

Based on the recent conversations and correspondence with the parties involved, the Division will remove Richard and Joyce Calkins as owners of License 6569 and ownership of the water right will remain with Fred Oliver and Robert Behlendorf, each with an undivided interest. All future correspondence regarding this water right, including determinations for annual fees, will be sent to the attention of Richard Secher. Unless we hear to the contrary within 30 days, we will assume that

you agree with this action, that Richard and Joyce Calkins will give up all claim to and interest in the water right, and that Messrs. Oliver and Behlendorf will abide by the terms and conditions of License 6569 and be responsible for paying the annual fees.

License 6569 authorizes the diversion of water from several wells along Estrella Creek. The points of diversion are specified in the license and the wells appear to be located on Mr. and Mrs. Calkin's property. Please be aware that the water right does not automatically convey a right of access to the authorized points of diversion. Messrs. Oliver and Behlendorf may need to get permission from Mr. and Mrs. Calkins or negotiate for a right of access to the authorized points of diversion. If the owners of the water right wish to move the point of diversion, they will likely need to file a change petition with the Division.

License 6569 also specifies the authorized place of use for water diverted under this water right. Most of Mr. Oliver's property (APN 027-191-048) appears to be included in the authorized place of use (please see the project drawing enclosed in the previous correspondence). However, only a portion (approximately 15 acres) of Mr. Behlendorf's property (APN 027-191-043) appears to be within the authorized place of use. If Mr. Behlendorf wishes to irrigate other portions of his property, he may need to file a petition for a change in the place of use.

Mr. Calkins indicated that the wells covered under the license are not currently in use and have not been used for several years. The owners of the water right should be aware that, pursuant to Water Code section 1675 et seq., a water right license may be lost through non-use. If the owners of the license wish to maintain the water right, all reasonable efforts should be made to put the water to beneficial use. 
Please note that the California Code of Regulations requires you to immediately inform the SWRCB of any change in address. The SWRCB will mail any notice(s), including fee notice(s), to the most recent address supplied. The regulations also require a water right holder to immediately file a statement informing the SWRCB of any change in ownership of the application, permit, or license. The statement shall refer to the number of the water right, and identify the name and address of the new owner. This is important because the failure to supply this information could result in your liability to pay water right fee(s), including penalty and interest for late payment, even after you have sold the property served by the right(s). bave made proof as of June 8, 1960, (the date of inspection) to the satisfaction of the State Water Rights Board of a right to the use of the water of Estrella Creek (underflow) in San Luis Obispo County

tributary to Salinas River

for the purpose of irrigation, domestic and stockwatering uses of the State Water Rights Board and that said right to the use of said water has been under Permit 10697 perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the Rules and Regulations of the State Water Rights Board and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from May 8, 1956 and that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed sixty-three hundredths (0.63) cubic foot per second to be diverted from about April 15 to about October 31 of each year and throughout the remainder of the year as required for domestic and stockwatering purposes.

The equivalent of such continuous flow allowance for any thirty-day period may be diverted in a shorter time if there be no interference with other vested rights.

The point S of diversion of such water are located:

All rights and privileges under this license including method of diversion, method of use and quantity of water diverted are subject to the continuing authority of the State Water Rights Board in accordance with law and in the interest of the public welfare to prevent waste, unreasonable use, unreasonable method of use or unreasonable method of diversion of said water.

Reports shall be filed promptly by licensee on appropriate forms which will be provided for the purpose from time to time by the State Water Rights Board.

The right hereby confirmed to the diversion and use of water is restricted to the point or points of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.

This license is granted and licensee accepts all rights herein confirmed subject to the following provisions of the Water Code:

Section 1625. Each license shall be in such form and contain such terms as may be prescribed by the board.

Section 1626. All licenses shall be under the terms and conditions of this division (of the Water Code).

Section 1627. A license shall be effective for such time as the water actually appropriated under it is used for a useful and beneficial purpose in conformity with this division (of the Water Code) but no longer.

Section 1628. Every license shall include the enumeration of conditions therein which in substance shall include all of the provisions of this article and the statement that any appropriator of water to whom a license is issued takes the license subject to the conditions therein expressed.


Section 1629. Every licensee, if he accepts a license does so under the conditions precedent that no value whatsoever in excess of the actual amount paid to the State therefor shall at any time be assigned to or claimed for any license granted or issued under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code), or for any rights granted or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code), in respect to the regulation by any competent public authority of the services or the price of the services to be rendered by any licensee or by the holder of any rights granted or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code) or in respect to any valuation for purposes of sale to or purchase, whether through condemnation proceedings or otherwise, by the State or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or any political subdivision of the State, of the rights and property of any licensee, or the possessor of any rights granted, issued, or acquired under the provisions of this division (of the Water Code).

Section 1630. At any time after the expiration of twenty years after the granting of a license, the State or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or any political subdivision of the State shall have the right to purchase the works and property occupied and used under the license and the works built or constructed for the enjoyment of the rights granted under the license.

Section 1631. In the event that the State, or any city, city and county, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district, or political subdivision of the State so desiring to purchase and the owner of the works and property cannot agree upon the purchase price, the price shall be determined in such manner as is now or may hereafter be provided by law for determining the value of property taken in eminent domain proceedings.
