

The Main Residence

Traditional charm radiates through light-filled spaces accented by bead-board wainscoting, antique plank flooring, and small-paned windows.

The large gourmet kitchen is perfect for family gatherings or gracious entertaining. A huge central island encourages multiple cooks, along with dual convection ovens, a double grill-top, ceramic stovetop with warming oven and generous storage; two dishwashers and double sinks makes clean-up easy, while a walk-in pantry keeps supplies close at hand. A gas fireplace and comfortable seating welcomes kibitzers and cook's helpers, while the dining area enjoys a splendid view.

The living room, featuring a used brick wood-burning fireplace, has French doors opening to porches on two sides. It can accommodate a large gathering, yet feels cozy with intimate groupings. Bookshelves and a music storage closet are built in.

The adjacent library is lined with bookshelves and offers desk space and storage with a pastoral view to the north. There is a full bath on the main floor, with a copper sink and the ambiance of the south of France.

A huge mud room /utility room with terra cotta tile floors

offers generous storage for all manner of gear. Hidden stairs lead to an attic under the eaves; a firewood storage area has a separate door to the outside to simplify loading cordwood.

On the upper level is the master suite with French doors out to a porch overlooking the property. The dressing area has generous closet space, the Jacuzzi tub overlooks the garden and the tiled shower has views toward Mt. Defiance.

The adjacent office/project room is an airy atelier with bookshelves, ample work tables and a sleeping alcove with a skylight for star gazing.
