The property has ample frontage along Highway 27 and Dewey Ballard Rd. The property has footage along the beautiful perennial stream, Halls Creek. Deer and Turkey can be found in abundant numbers but the real value of this property may be found in large gravel deposits (A sand & gravel company is just next door).

Timber stands on the property consist of 31 acres of Large Hardwoods along Halls Creek, 71 acres of 14 yr old planted pines that are ready to be thinned, and 6.5 acres of midsized hardwoods along drains. There are currently 6 acres in food plots. The new

owner will also have 322 acres of vigorously growing, 1 year old containerized planted pines (2011).






