



## **Executive Summary**

<u>CURRENT USE</u>: The Farms at Leedstown is an assemblage of three farms made several decades ago by the present owners for growing nursery stock of Ingleside Plantation Nursery. A shift from field grown stock to container inventory has greatly reduced the acreage needed. Hence, these farms are no longer essential. The owners are negotiable regarding releasing the property to a new owner/tenant or a short-term leaseback.

<u>SUMMARY OF ASSETS</u>: An excerpt of the National Resources Conservation Service soils inventory for these farms is included and describes the soils as predominately Pamunkey, Kempsville and other types, many of which are considered among the best for agricultural production in Tidewater Virginia.

An oil and gas lease has been executed with an exploration company (copy attached). One-half of the mineral rights will be retained by the Seller.

Two blocks of timber have been cruised estimating the value of merchantable timber at approximately \$210,000.

An attractive two-story house over a basement, estimated by the county assessors office to be approximately 4,000 square feet is located on a hill on the Bunker Hill North farm. There is also a modern equipment shed located on Cedar Hill Farm.

HISTORY AND COMMUNITY: All of the farms are located in the Leedstown area of Westmoreland County, the site of the Leedstown Resolutions. The Virginia Department of Historical Resources nearby historical marker reads as follows: "At Leadstown, seven miles south, an association was formed to resist the enforcement of the Stamp Act, February 27, 1766. The resolutions, drafted by the Revolutionary leader, Richard Henry Lee, were one of the first protests against the Stamp Act and influenced public opinion in all the Colonies."


Today the area is intensely agricultural, primarily for row crops of corn, small grain and vegetables. A number of plantation homes are nearby, including Liberty, Wirtland, Roxbury, Walnut Hill, Ingleside and Twiford.





## Regional & State Map




# Soil Map Bunker Hill North/Cedar Hill/Jeffries







# **Zoning Map**


