

Field note description for 6.000 acres of land out of Tract A of Spring Creek Subdivision, Tom Green County, Texas, as the same is shown on the plat recorded June 16, 1971, In Book 3, Page 161, of the Plat Records of Tom Green County, Texas, described in Field Notes recorded in Vol. 578, P. 92, of the Deed Records of Tom Green County, Texas, and being the east one half of that certain 12 acres of land conveyed by deed from Louis D. Ely and wifee Connie R. Ely, to L. O. Barton and Melvin C. Probst, recorded in Vol. 594, Pp. 256-258, Deed Records of Tom Green County, Texas and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at a 5/8 inch iron rod found for the northeast corner of the 6.0 acre tract previously conveyed to Jack Orion Barton and Kristi D. Barton Gette by deed of partition recorded in Vol. 761, P. 456, Deed Records of Tom Green County, Texas and being the northwest corner of this tract;

Thence N 75 degrees 03 minutes 32 seconds E 626.13 feet with the northerly boundary of this tract and the south boundary of a 12.98 acre tract as recorded in Vol. 444, P. 100, O.P.R. to a ¾ iron pipe found for the northeasterly corner of this tract;

Thence S 20 degrees 05 minutes 10 seconds E, 419.09 feet with the easterly boundary line of this tract to a ½ inch iron pipe found for the southeasterly corner of this tract:

Thence S 75 degrees 02 minutes 58 seconds W, 626.52 feet with the southerly boundary line of this tract along the north boundary line of Ponderosa Estates, recorded in Plat Cabinet B No 183-184, to a 5/8 inch iron rod found for the southwesterly corner of this tract and the southeasterly corner of the said 6.0 acre Barton tract;

Thence N 19 degrees 59 minutes 14 seconds W, 209.76 feet with the westerly boundary of this tract and the easterly boundary line of said 6.0 acre Barton tract to a 2 inch diameter steel pipe fence corner post found for the southeasterly corner of a 3.0 acre tract recorded in Vol. 752, p. 722, O.P.R. also being the southeasterly corner of a 20 ft. easement recorded in Vol. 752, P. 719 O.P.R.;

Thence N 20 degrees 04 minutes 35 seconds W, at 20.00 feet pass the northeasterly corner of said 20 ft. easement, 209.40 feet in all with the westerly boundary line of this tract and the easterly boundary line of said Barton tract to the PLACE OF BEGINNING containing an area of 6.000 acres of land.
