<u>FOR REFERENCE</u> begin at a 1-1/4 inch iron pipe found at the intersection of the North line of said 80 Ac. tract and in the West line of STATE HIGHWAY NO. 71, same being in the North line of a called 5 Ac. tract (Vol. 722, Pg. 116; D.R.) and in the South line of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of said SURVEY NO. 36 (Vol. 398, Pg. 221; D.R.);

<u>THENCE</u> WEST, with the North line of said 80 Ac. tract, same being with the common line between said Northeast Quarter (NE/4) and said Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of said SURVEY NO. 36, 234.0 ft. to a 5/8 inch iron rod found for the **upper Northeast** and <u>BEGINNING</u> corner hereof, same being the Northwest corner of said 5 Ac. tract;

<u>THENCE</u> SOUTH, 660.00 ft. to a 5/8 inch iron found for an **interior corner** hereof, same being the Southwest corner of said 5 Ac. tract;

THENCE EAST, at 234.0 ft. pass a 5/8 inch iron rod found in the West line of said STATE HIGHWAY NO. 71, and in all, 330.00 ft. to a point in the East line of said SURVEY NO. 36, same being in the East line of said 80 Ac. tract for the **lower Northeast corner** hereof, same being the Southeast corner of said 5 Ac. tract;

<u>THENCE</u> North 51 Deg. 37 Min. 00 Sec. West, generally with the centerline of TADPOLE CREEK, 2019.11 ft. (called 2019.16 ft.) to a point in the North line of said 80 Ac. tract for the **WEST corner** hereof, same being a corner of said 48.31 Ac. tract; from which corner a 1-1/4 inch iron pipe found for the Northwest corner of said 80 Ac. and said 48.31 Ac. tracts bears, WEST, 961.27 ft.;
