

At a town board meeting of Carsonville Township in Becker County, Minnesota held on the 2nd day of November, 1989 at Ponsford o'clock 8 m. at the town hall in said township, Supervisor Jerene Boye introduced and moved the adoption of the following Resolution, which was seconded by Supervisor Jerene Boye, and unanimously adopted by the town board of supervisors:

WHEREAS, Carsonville Township in Becker County, Minnesota contains a number of township roads, and

WHEREAS, Nearly all of the township roads have been established by use and/or prescription or by dedication and there may or may not be a record of said roads recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Becker County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, The township board of supervisors has determined it to be in the best interest of the township, the public and all parties concerned to determine and record the center line location of said duly established town roads, and

WHEREAS, The town board has caused to be prepared a road map indicating the location of said town roads contained in the township, and

WHEREAS, The town board held a public hearing on the proposal on the 2nd day of November, 1989 at 8 o'clock 8 m. and that notice of said hearing was provided according to law,

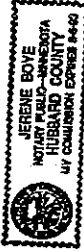
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the roads and road rights of way listed on the attached Exhibit "A" are hereby determined to be the duly established center lines of the four-rod roads in said township and the center lines of the roads and road rights of way listed on attached Exhibit "B" are hereby determined to be the duly established two-rod cartways and roads in said township, all as shown on attached Road Map.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That all town roads which lie upon and follow the boundaries of the township of Carsonville Township and adjacent townships, or other abutting political units, are deemed to lie in equal proportion in the township and the abutting political units, unless expressly indicated otherwise.

Exhibit A

The following is the centerline description of all four road rights of way:

Town Road 1

Beginning at or near the NW corner of section two. Then in an easterly direction on or along the N township boundary line 8660 feet or 1.64 miles more or less to a point on the northern township boundary line in section one at or near the NW corner of government lot two, section one and there terminating.

Total length of road is 1.64 miles more or less.

Town Road 2

Beginning at a point 100 feet more or less W of the SW corner of section two. Then easterly on or along the section lines 10,700 feet or 2.03 miles more or less to a point 100 feet more or less W of the eastern township boundary line near the SE corner of section one. Then curving southeasterly 100 feet more or less to a point on or along the E township boundary and the E line of section twelve, then southerly 5,500 feet or 1.04 miles on or along the E line of sections 12 and 13 to the intersection of State Highway #225 and there terminating. Said intersection is 200 feet more or less S of the SE corner of section twelve.

Total length of road is 3.09 miles more or less.

Town Road 3

Beginning at or near the NW corner of section one. Then southerly on or along the section lines 3.5 miles more or less to a point at or near the SW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 24. Total length of road is 3.5 miles more or less.

Town Road 4

Commencing at the intersection of State Highway #225 at or near the SW corner of section 11. Then easterly along the S line of section 11, 200 feet more or less to the point of beginning. Then in a westerly direction 2840 feet or .54 miles more or less, on or along the N section line of sections 14 and 15 to a point and there terminating.

Total length of road being .54 miles more or less.

Town Road 5

Commencing at the intersection of State Highway #225 at or near the NE corner of section 15. Then 200 feet more or less north of the NE corner of section 15 to the point of beginning. Then southerly on or along the section lines 9400 feet or 1.78 miles more or less to a point. Then curving S 48° E 400 feet more or less to a point. Then southerly 1200 feet more less to a point

which is 600 feet more or less E of the SW corner of section 23, said point being on or near said section line. Then continuing in a southwesterly direction S 50° W 1080 feet more or less or .2 miles to a point. Then in a southeasterly direction S 12° E 3000 feet or .57 miles more or less to the intersection of State Highway #34 in the SW ¼ of section 26 and there terminating.

Total length of road is 2.85 miles more or less.

Town Road 6

Beginning at the intersection of State Highway #34 near the SE corner of the NE ¼ of the NW ¼ of section 25. Then in a northerly direction 1500 feet or .28 miles more or less to the S line of section 24. This portion of road is described in Easement #133-26-32 drafted by Becker County Highway Engineer and described as: Beginning at the SE corner of the said NE ¼; thence N 66.0 feet; thence N and parallel to the E line of the said NE ¼ NW ¼, 370.0 feet; thence deflect 10° 41 feet right a distance of 360.0 feet more or less to the said E line of the said NE ¼ NW ¼; thence S 720.0 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating, containing 0.83 acres more or less. Then continuing northerly 2600 feet or .49 mile more or less to a point at or near the center of section 24, then curving westerly on or along said ¼ line 2600 feet or .49 miles more or less to the W line of section 24, then continuing westerly on or along the E-W ¼ line of section 23, 1800 feet or .34 miles more or less to a point, then in a more or less northwesterly direction N 70° W 850 feet more or less to a point, then in a southwesterly direction S 65° W 3200 feet or .61 miles more or less to a point, which is 300 feet more or less E of the W section line of section 23. Said point being near the NW corner of the SW ¼ of the SW ¼ of section 23.

Total length of road is 2.38 miles more or less.

Town Road 7

Beginning at the intersection of Highway 34, near the NE corner of section 33. Said point of intersection is located 600 feet more or less SW; S 70° W of said NE corner of section 33. Then in a northwesterly direction N 85° W 100 feet more or less to a point, then southwesterly S 70° W 300 feet more or less to a point, then northwesterly N 55° W 450 feet more or less to a point, then southwesterly S 10° W 1100 feet more or less to a point, then S 400 feet more or less to a point, then southwesterly S 12° W 100 feet more or less to a point, thence northwesterly N 40° W 1100 feet more or less to a point, thence westerly on or along the N section line of section 33 1950 feet more or less to the E section line of section 32, then westerly on or along the section line 5280 feet or 1 mile more or less to the E section line of section 31, then westerly 1850 feet or .35

distance of 2000 feet more or less to the west township boundary
at or near the intersection of CSAH 39.

Total length of road is 3.31 miles more or less.

Town Road 8
Beginning at the intersection of State Highway #34 at or near the
SE corner of section 31. Then northerly 1 mile more or less to
the NE corner of section 31.

Total length of road is 1 mile more or less.

Town Road 9
Beginning at or near the SW corner of section 33, at the
intersection of County Road #121, then easterly on or along the S
township boundary 5280 feet or 1 mile more or less to a point and
there terminating.

Total length of road is 1 mile more or less.

Town Road 10
Beginning at or near the W township boundary at or near the NW
corner of section 30, at or near the intersection of CSAH #39,
then easterly on or along said township line 800 feet or .15
miles more or less to a point and there terminating.

Total length of road is .15 miles more or less.

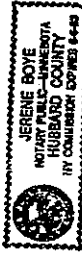

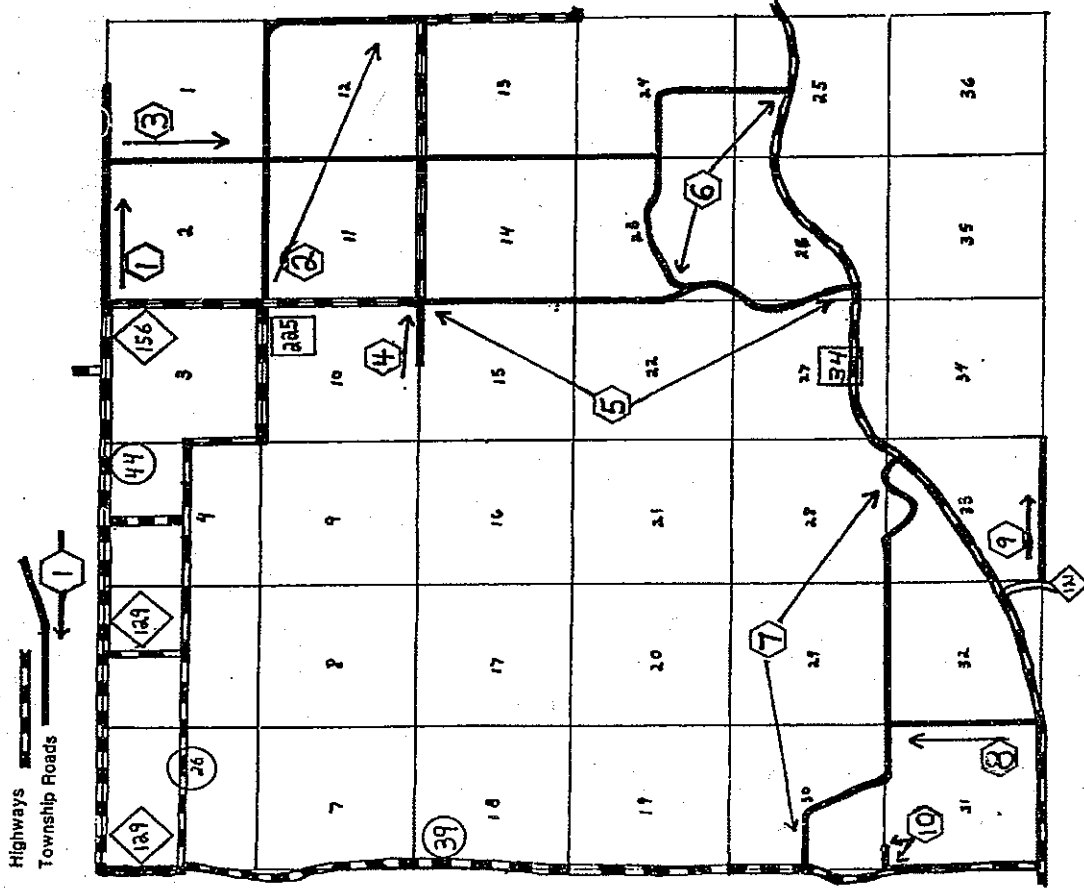
