



Logal description of the land

All that certain tract or parcel of land situated in Cass County, Texas, a part of the William Hollingsworth Survey A-511 and being also a part of that 53 acre tract described in a deed from John W. Wilson to Bradley Burber as recorded in Vol. 509, Page 764 of the Deed Records of said county and bounded as follows:

Beginning at an iron rod for corner, the Northeast corner of the William Hollingsworth Survey being also the Northeast corner of the aforementioned 53 acre tract;

Thence—South 2° 16° 12" West along the East boundary line of the William Hollingworth Survey being also the Fast boundary line of the 53 acre tract \$33.68 feet to an iron rod for corner in the centerline of a County Road, being also the Northeast corner of the 9.412 acre tract #3 this day surveyed out:

Thence—North 75° 43′ 12″ West along the centerline of the County Road and the North boundary line of Tract #3, 118.12 feet to the beginning of a curve to the left:

Thence Northwesterly around the curve, long chord bears North 82° 13' 47" West 285.93 feet. Radius = 1260.98 feet through a central angle of 13° 0' 11" for a total distance of 286.54 feet the end of the curve:

Thence North 88° 44° 23° West continuing along the centerline of the County Road and the North boundary line of

Fract #3, 38.63 leet to an iron rod for corner, the Northwest corner of Tract #3 being also the Southeast corner of a 9.604 here Fract #1 this day surveyed out:

Thence North 10° 8° 12" West 707.05 feet to an iron rod for corner in the North boundary line of the William Hollingsworth Survey being also the North boundary line of the 53 acre tract said corner being also the Northeast corner of the aforementioned Tract #1:

Thence South 89° 33′ 58" Last along the North boundary line 243.45 feet to an angle point:

Thence South 875 02' 00" East continuing along the North boundary line 366.85 feet to the Place of Beginning and containing 0.001 acres of land, more or less.
