Today the property is covered in planted sweetgum, loblolly pine, and natural hardwood. There is an excellent system of roads and drainage ditches (constructed for agricultural purposes) throughout the tract. Wildlife abound – primarily whitetail deer and turkey – and food plots are numerous. There are 46 acres of natural pine with merchantable timber and 69 acres of natural hardwood.

Property Use: This is an extremely versatile tract offering a long-term investment in timber production, the possibility of rural development along the ample road frontage, plus the chance of conversion from timber back to row crop agricultural use. Recreation possibilities are bountiful for hunting, trail riding, and much more.
