7. In accordance with Section 37-90-112(1) and Section 37-90-111(1)(g), C.R.S., the requested change was advertised in the Tri-County Tribune on April 25 and May 2, 1996. No objections were received within the required thirty (30) days.

8. In order to prevent injury to the existing water rights of others in the Alluvial Aquifer of the Kiowa-Bijou Designated Ground Water Basin, it is necessary to impose conditions on the proposed change. Under conditions as stated in the Order, no material injury will occur to other existing water rights.

ORDER

In accordance with Section 37-90-111(1)(g), C.R.S., the Colorado Ground Water Commission orders that the applications to separate the irrigation use of the wells with Permit Nos. 10379-F and 10380-F and change the description of irrigated acres are approved subject to the following conditions:

1. The use of each well shall be limited to irrigation of the following described area in Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 62 West of the 6th Principal Meridian:

Permit No. 10379-F, 50 acres in a described tract of land located in the NE1/4 of said Section 9.

Permit No. 10380-F. The south 50 acres of a tract of land described as the west 333.3 feet of the NE1/4 and the east 837.1 feet of the NW1/4 of said Section 9.

- 2. The wells are limited to the following maximum annual appropriations.
 - 125 acre-feet for Permit No. 10379-F
 - 125 acre-feet for Permit No. 10380-F

FINDINGS AND ORDER OF THE COLORADO GROUND WATER COMMISSION

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATIONS TO CHANGE THE DESCRIPTION OF ACRES PERMITTED TO BE IRRIGATED BY THE WELLS WITH PERMIT NOS. 10379-F and 10380-F.

APPLICANTS:

PATRICK MCCONNELL & PAUL AND MICHELLE MANSFIELD

FINDINGS

- 1. On October 20, 1965, the State Engineer issued Permit Nos. 10379-F and 10380-F as registrations for two existing wells. The claimed well location for 10379-F was the SE1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 9, Township 4 South, Range 62 West of the 6th Principal Meridian. The claimed well location for 10380-F was the SW1/4 of the NE1/4 of said Section 9. The date of initiation of use for the wells was described as "During 1949". Land claimed to have been Irrigated by the wells was described as "NE1/4" of said Section 9. No amount of claimed acres or more complete description of irrigated area was indicated in the permits for these wells.
- 2. Statements of Beneficial Use filed by Patrick McConnell on January 30, 1996, and by Paul and Michelle Mansfield on October 19, 1995, claim that the wells historically Irrigated, together in common, 100 acres described as: 80 acres to the west of Comanche Creek in the NE1/4 and in the SE1/4 of the NW1/4 of said Section 9 and 20 acres to the east of Comanche Creek in the NE1/4 of said Section 9, with a total combined annual appropriation of 250 acre-feet.
- The wells in question are located in the Kiowa-Bijou Designated Ground Water Basin and In the North Kiowa-Bijou Ground Water Management District. The Colorado Ground Water Commission has jurisdiction.
- 4. In a Stipulated Agreement filed on January 10, 1996, Patrick McConnell and Paul and Michelle Mansfield agreed to separate the irrigation use of the two wells, with each well to irrigate up to 50 acres of land with an annual appropriation not to exceed 125 acre-feet.
- 5. By applications received complete from Patrick McConnell on January 30, 1996, for Permit No. 10379-F, and from Paul and Michelle Mansfield on October 19, 1995, for Permit No. 10380-F, the applicants requested to separate the use of the wells and change the description of acres to be irrigated by each well to the following described areas:
- Permit No. 10379-F, 50 acres in a described tract of land located in the NE1/4 of said Section 9. (as illustrated in a map attached hereto as Exhibit A)
- Permit No. 10380-F. The south 50 acres of a tract of land described as the west 333.3 feet of the NE1/4 and the east 837.1 feet of the NW1/4 of said Section 9.
- 6. The number of acres proposed to be served by the two wells does not exceed the acreage permitted and originally irrigated by the wells as evidenced by the abovementioned Statements of Beneficial Use.
