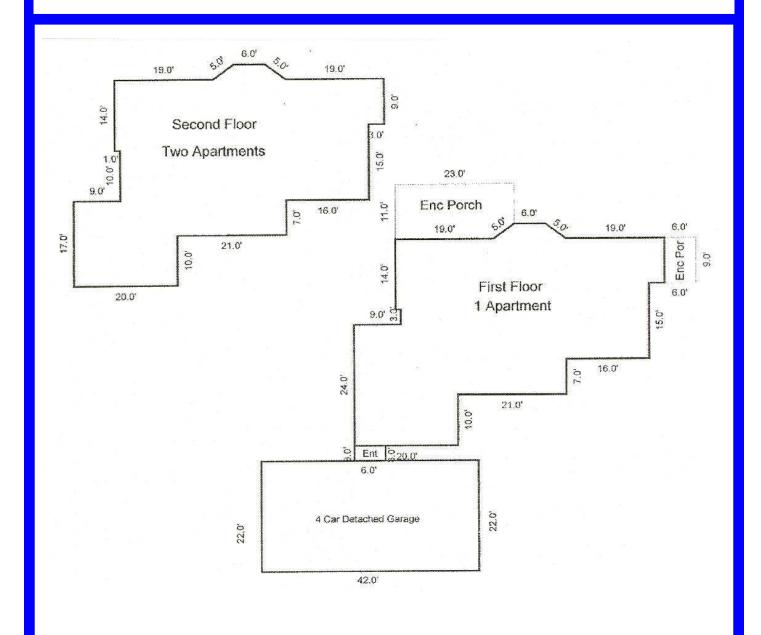


TAX MAP



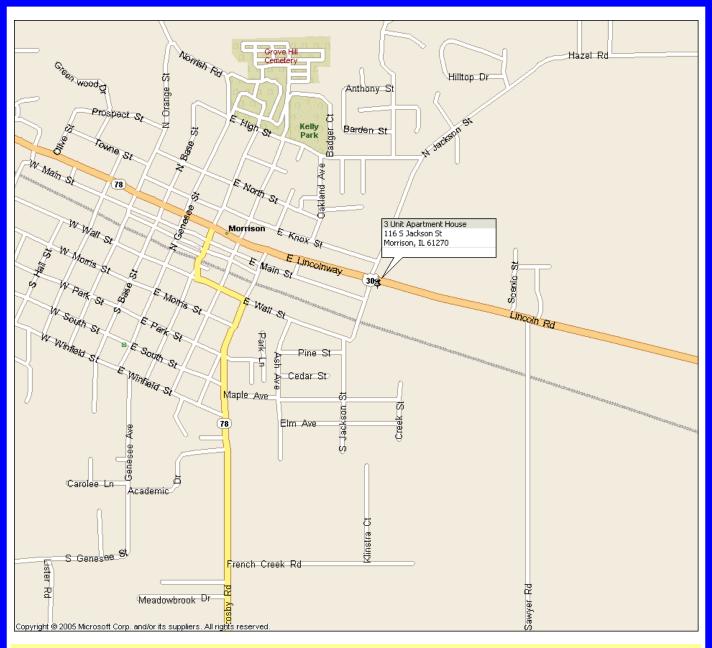
