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Location: Just over an hour north of Boise, Idaho, and 30 minutes northeast of Sweet, Idaho in a great mountain setting with creek frontage and timber. Also accessible from Sweet, Idaho via Dry Buck Road.

Acreage: 520± acres. Pine trees, creek frontage, and mountainous terrain. Adjacent to Forest Service on the east and State Lands on the west. Property has several knobs providing great views of the mountainous terrain. Year-round recreation as long as you have a snowmobile in the winter. (Depending on the weather, the property may be accessible with 4wheel drive vehicle some winters). Phone is available. Power is not at the property.

Recreation: There is ample recreation available from horseback riding to ATVing to hunting to hiking and more. The Boise National Forest is at your doorstep and your can go any direction on or off the property to find recreation opportunities. Make this your hunting ground for elk, deer or bear.
