





# Macro market % population LESS THAN 10 YEARS OLD — 2008 data






## Macro market % POPULATION 10 TO 17 YEARS OLD – 2008 data






## Macro market % POPULATION 18 TO 24 YEARS OLD - 2008 data










## Macro market % POPULATION 45 TO 54 YEARS OLD – 2008 data






## Macro market % POPULATION 55 TO 64 YEARS OLD – 2008 data












## MCLENNAN COUNTY % population by age segments - 2008 data








# LIMESTONE COUNTY % population by age segments - 2008 data






# FALLS COUNTY % population by age segments - 2008 data






# BELL COUNTY % population by age segments - 2008 data






