Notes - All streets & avenues are 80 ft. wide, except Ave. C & H, which are 100 ft. wide. South end of Ave. H is 80 ft. wide. Blocks 9 to 14 inclusive are 120 x 80 ft. Blocks 4, 5 & 6 are 100 ft x 80 ft. The area of all other blocks is determined by the lengths of lines indicated. All whole lots are 120 ft x 80 ft.
