THENCE N 19-40 E slong a wire fence being the West line of an abandoned county road, at 765.7 feet a steel pin set at the base of a 5 inch cedar post, an interior corner of this;

THENCE N 20-14 E along the wire fence 351.9 feet to a steel pin set in the South line of F.M. Hwy. 2005, said pin the NEC of this;

THENCE S 57-01 W along the South R. O. W. line, at 326.8 feet a steel pin set at the P. C. of a circular curve to the right, an interior corner of this;
