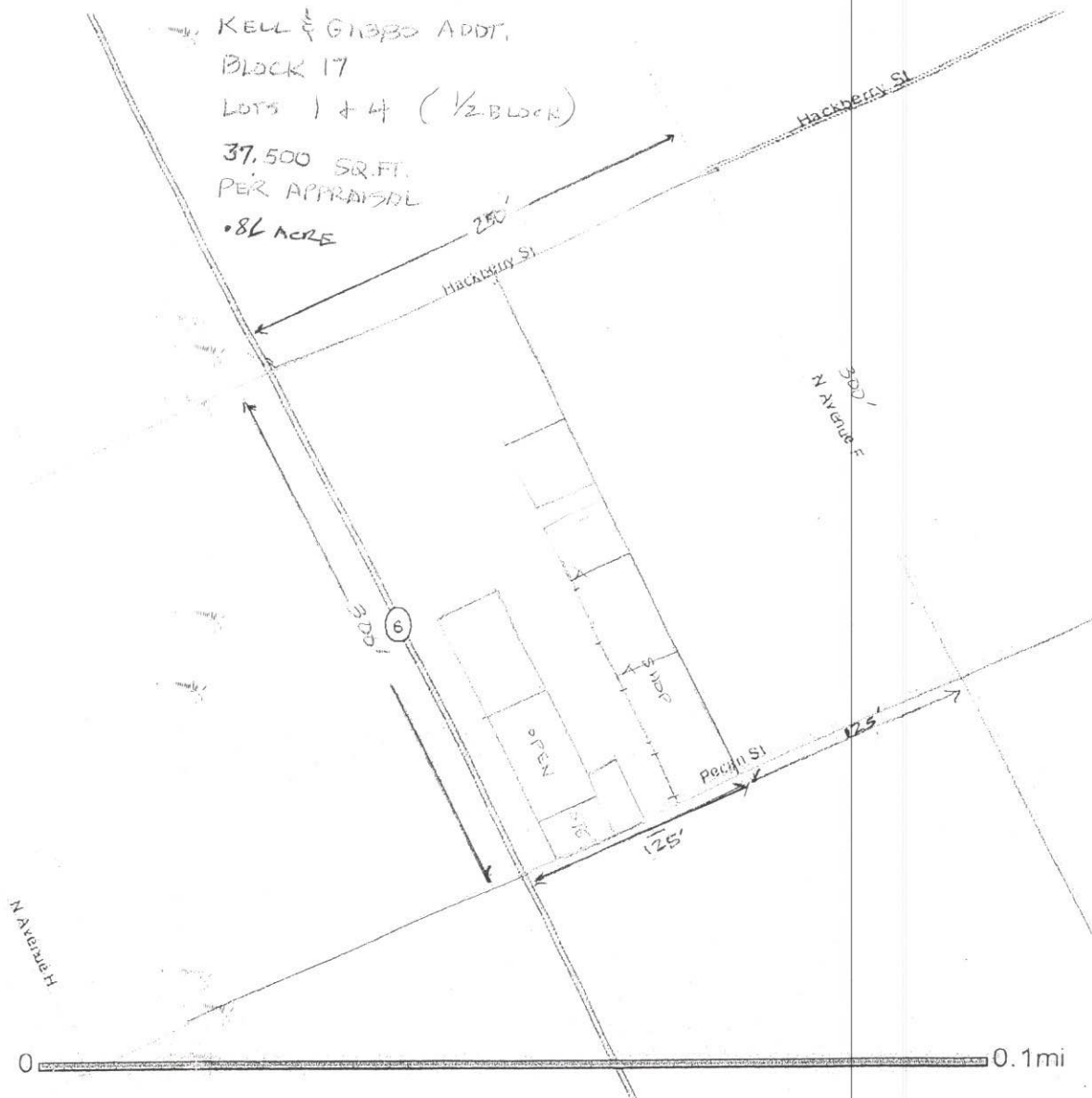
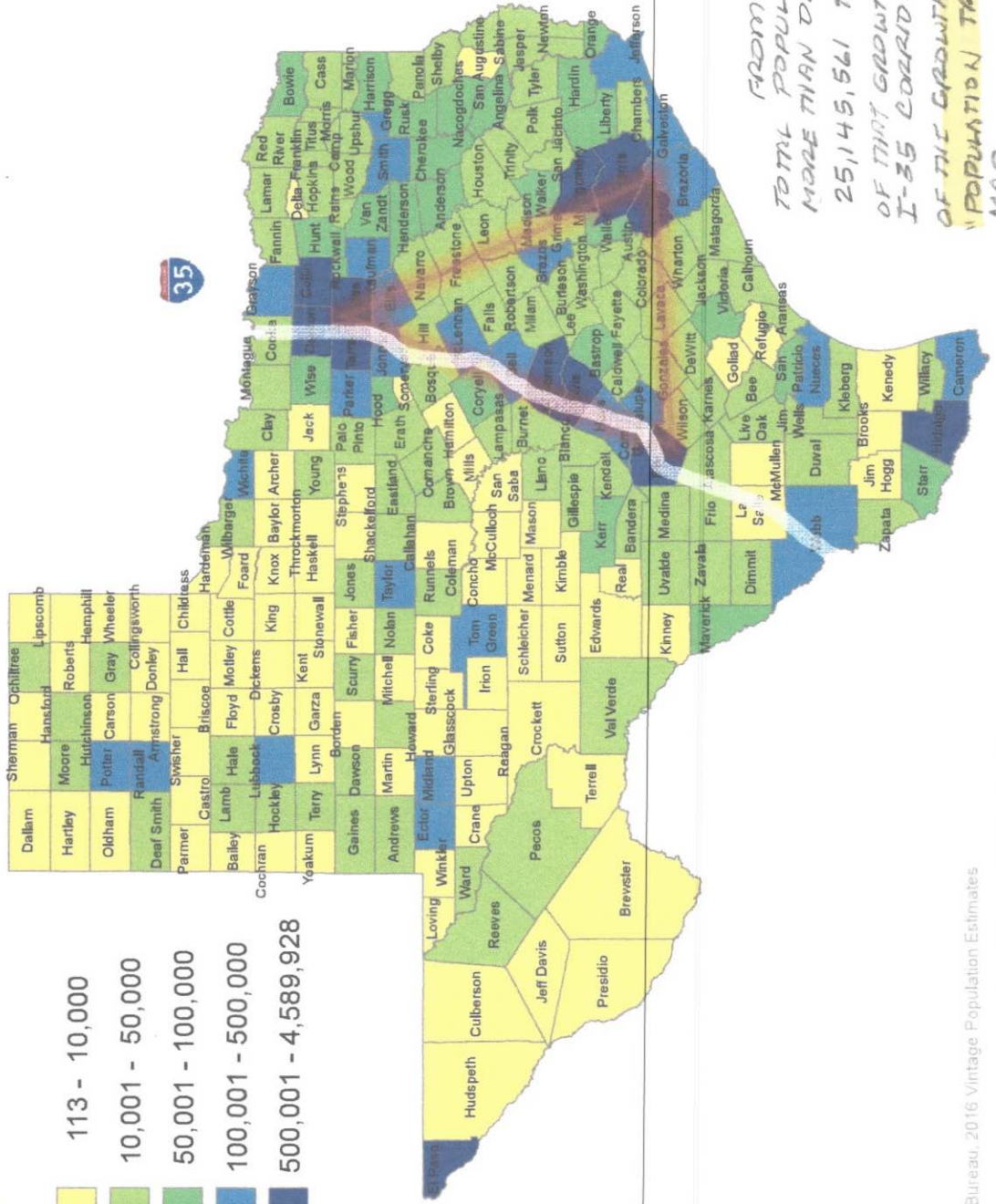
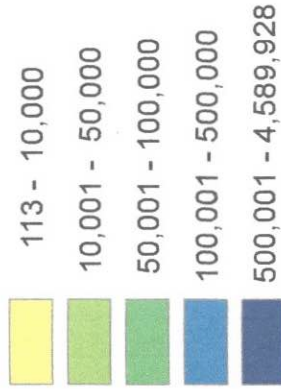






Total Estimated Population by County, Texas, 2016

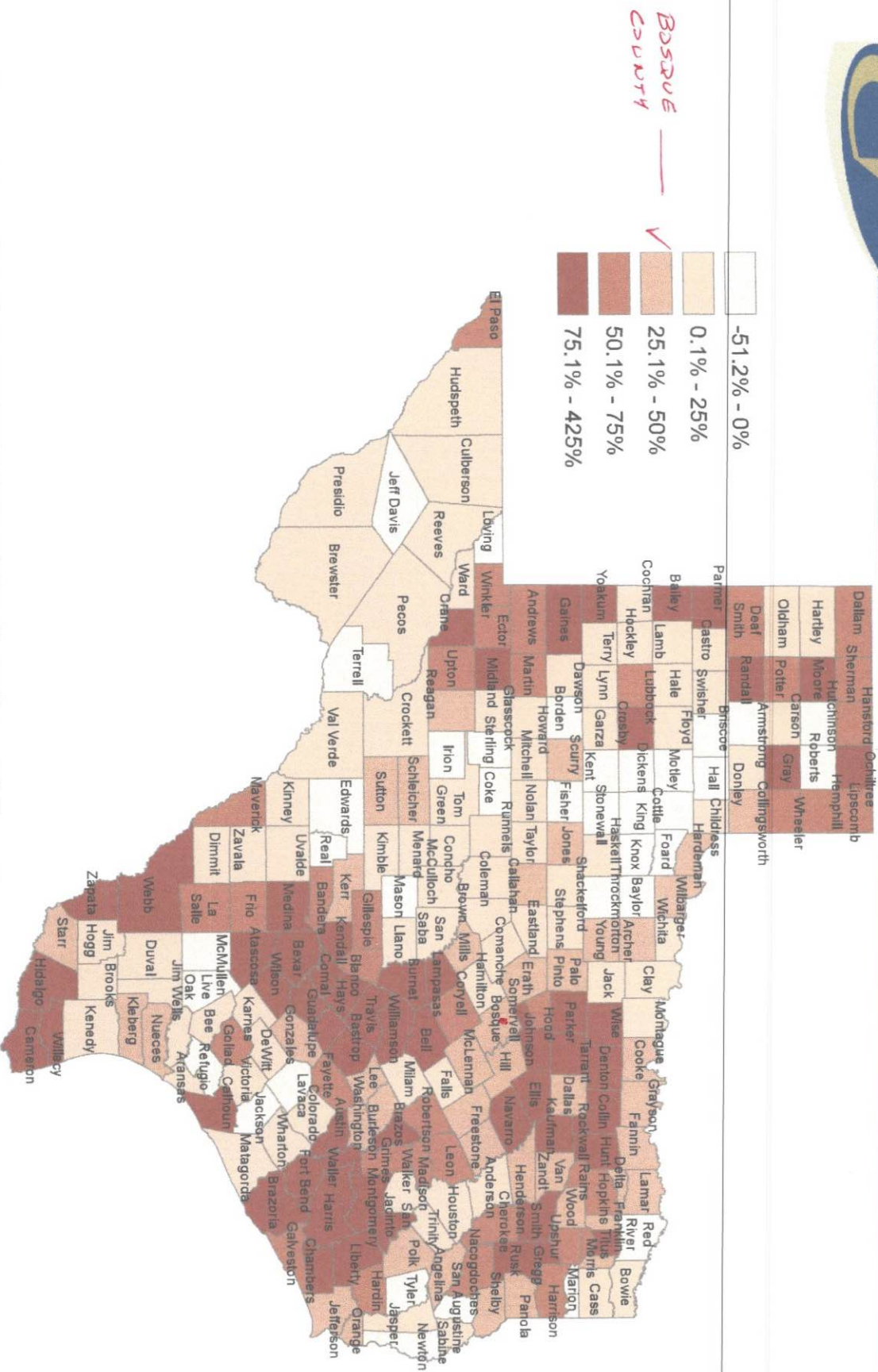

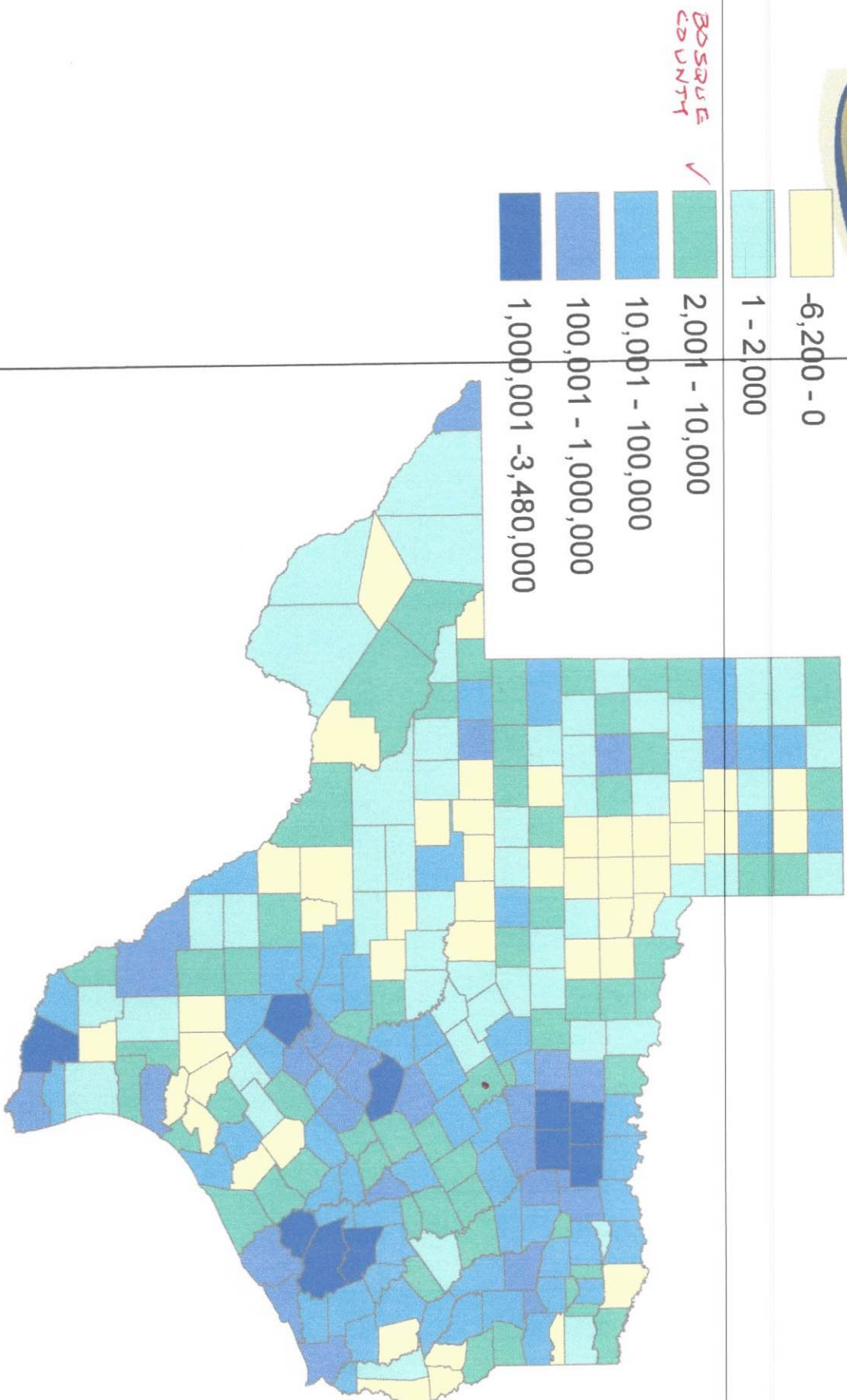
Projected Percent Change in Population 2010-2050

Projections by Age, Sex, and Race/Ethnicity

Age

When compared to the other age categories, the age category including Texans over 65 years of age is projected to grow at the fastest rate. Seniors, those over 65 years of age, are projected to more than triple in size from 2010 to 2050, approaching 7.9 million. The age category including those 45 to 64 years of age is projected to be the second fastest growing age group, growing 55% by 2050 to a population of over 9.3 million. The younger age categories are projected to continue a slower but steady growth, with children, ages 0 to 4 and 5 to 17, projected to be the slowest growing age groups.

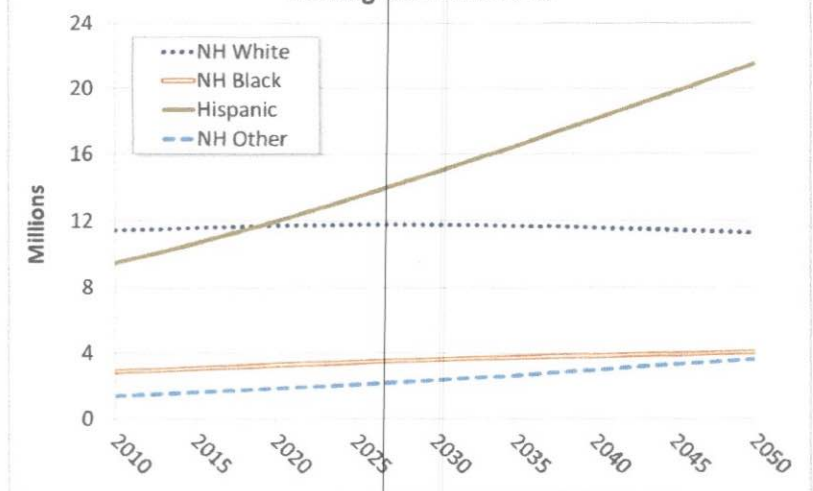
Sex

The 2010 Census showed nearly equal proportions of males and females in the state, with slightly more females than males. Each group is projected to grow to over 20 million by 2050. Although the projections begin with a slight female advantage, the projections horizon ends with slightly more males than females.

Race/Ethnicity

Projections indicate that the non-Hispanic Other group, consisting of mostly Asian Americans, will grow at the fastest rate, when compared to other

racial/ethnic categories. The non-Hispanic Other population is projected to near 3.7 million by 2050, a population growth rate yielding more than 2.5 times the 2010 population. While the non-Hispanic Other population is growing at the fastest rate, it is projected that this group will continue to make up the smallest proportion of the total State population when compared to other racial/ethnic categories.

The Hispanic population is growing at a rapid rate as well as increasing its proportion of the total State population. Our projections suggest the Hispanic population will increase to nearly 2.3 times its size in 2010 to 21.5 million by 2050. The non-Hispanic black population is projected to increase at a
