DESCRIPTION OF SURVEY NO. 85-025-01

Being a tract of land in Sherman District of Hampshire County, West Virginia, lying along the North side of Route 7/3 about 250' West of Route 29, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a Planted Stone, corner to two tracts of Galen Shingleton and also corner to land of Claude Davis, thence with the Davis land,

S 58 55 48 W in all 1038.35' (this line passes through a fence post at 700.22, Claude Davis corner, and continues with Eugene Tutwiler 330.13') to a Railroad Spike set in the center of Route 7/3, thence with the road,

N 54 58 48 W 28.40',

N 61 22 53 W 37.85',

N 65 14 15 W 131.16',

N 56 19 56 W 44.75',

N 50 43 50 W 67.97',

N 44 44 57 W 39.87', thence leaving the road and running a new line through the Hawse land,

N 57 29 29 E 1105.09' to a 5/8" Re-Bar set in the Shingleton line, thence with Shingleton,

S 45 50 54 E 350.00' to the beginning, containing 8.089 Acres as Surveyed by Frank A. Whitacre and as shown on the attached Plat.

Being a portion of the land conveyed to Daniel Hawse by deed recorded in Deed Book 238 at page 388.
