RESIDENTIAL SEPTIC SYSTEM DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Section 32.1-164.1:1 Code of Virginia provides whenever any onsite sewage system is failing and is on or serves real property consisting of not less than one nor more than four dwelling units and the Board of Health's (Board) regulations for repairing such failing system impose (i) a requirement for treatment beyond the level of treatment provided by the existing onsite sewage system when operating properly or (ii) a new requirement for pressure dosing, the Owner may request a waiver from such requirements. The Commissioner shall grant any request for such waiver, unless he finds that the failing system was installed illegally without a permit. Any such waivers shall be recorded in the land records of the clerk of the circuit court in the jurisdiction in which the property on

NOTE TO PURCHASER(S): Pursuant to Section 32.1-164.1:1, the Owner is required to deliver the Disclosure, if applicable, to the Purchaser prior to the acceptance of a real estate purchase contract with respect to the Property. If disclosure is applicable and is delivered to the purchaser after the acceptance of the real estate purchase contract, the purchaser's sole remedy shall be to terminate the real estate purchase contract at or prior to the earliest of the following: (i) three days after delivery of the disclosure in person; (ii) five days after the postmark if the disclosure is deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, and properly addressed to the purchaser; (iii) settlement upon purchase of the property; (iv) occupancy of the property by the purchaser; (v) the execution by the purchaser of a written waiver of the purchaser's right of termination under this chapter contained in a writing separate from the real estate purchase contract; or (vi) the purchaser making written application to a lender for a mortgage loan where such application contains a disclosure that the right of termination shall end upon the application for the mortgage loan. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT BY SELLER AND PURCHASER

The Virginia Residential Property Disclosure Act (§ 55-517 et seq. of the Code of Virginia) requires the owner of certain residential real property—whenever the property is to be sold or leased with an option to buy—to provide notification to the purchaser of any disclosures required by the Act and to refer the purchaser to the Real Estate Board website referenced below for additional information.
