The the grantor to a committee of lot owners within said subdivision, ted by the property owners, and any assessment made pursuant to this igraph shall constitute a lien on each and every lot within said livision until paid, and payment of said assessment and levy shall be able on or before the 31st day of January next following the purchase said lot, and on or before the 31st day of January of each year therewer. Where more than one lot is owned by a party or parties, in the at of a resale of one or more said lots, then the obligation to pay the 1 \$25.00 assessment shall become the obligation of the new owner(s).
- (3) The grantor reserves unto himself, his heirs or assigns, the at to erect and maintain telephone and electric light poles, conduits ipment, sewer, gas and water lines, or to grant easements or rights-of-therefore, with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of erect-or maintenance on, over, or under a strip of land fifteen (15) feet wide any point along the side, rear, or front lines of any of said lots.
- (4) No building of a temporary nature shall be erected or placed on of said lots except those customarily erected in connection with !ding operations; and in such cases, for a period not to exceed four (ths. This shall not prohibit the erection of a tiolet complying with visions of Paragraph 9 below.
- (5) Minimum size of any residence constructed shall contain at least square feet on the floor. This shall not include basement, garage, ch or carport. All exterior construction must be completed and closed within eight (8) months of the commencement of construction. No part any lot sold by the grantor may be sold or used as a road or as a ht-of-way to any property outside of said subdivision. This covenant ll not apply until said lots are sold by the grantor.
- (6) All of said lots shall be used for recreational purposes only, any garage or barn must conform generally in appearance and material h any dwelling on said lot.
- (7) No signs, billboards, or advertising of any nature shall be ted, placed or maintained on any lots herein designated, nor upon any ling erected thereon, except directional and information signs of
- intor. (8) No building shall be erected closer than 100 feet to any street road, nor closer than 50 feet to the side or rear of the lot line, with exception that when two or more lots are used together for the conruction of one dwelling, then said 50 foot set-back shall apply to outlines.

- (9) All toilets constructed on said lots shall conform to the gulation of the appropriated County and State Health Department, and placed in a secluded area whenever possible. No building shall be om the State Department of Health.
- (10) No lot in said subdivision may be resubdivided into more an two (2) lots. The minimum size of each lot subdivided, including a lot retained by the owner, shall not be less than five (5) acres. State Department of Health may not issue septic tank permits on subdivisions.
- (11) In the event that any trailer or mobile type of home is placed the lot, the same shall be placed on a permanent foundation, or in the sernative, the space between the ground floor of the mobile home and the mod level shall be concealed by the use of a wall of a similar type permit the use of a permanent thousand; no such camping trailer or camper that the permitted to remain on any lot for a period in excess of four (4)
- (12) Twelve (12") inch diameter culverts must be used in all drives leading from main subdivision roads.
- (13) No trucks, buses, old cars or unsightly vehicles of any type description may be left or abandoned on said lots.
- (14) Nothing herein is to be construed to prevent the grantor from cing further covenants or easements on any lot in said subdivision which li not have already been conveyed by them.
- (15) If the parties hereto, or any of them, or their heirs or igns shall violate or attempt to violate any of the covenants herein, shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any real estate in said subdivision to prosecute any proceedings at law or in ity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate such covenant, either to prevent him or them from so doing or to over damages or other dues for such violation.
- (16) Invalidation of any of these covenants by judgement or Court r, shall in nowise affect any of the other provisions which shall rein full force and effect.
