PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

When assessing quality hunting and recreational properties, habitat diversity is generally the most desirable attribute because this aspect can be difficult to find or replicate. The natural balance of Beaver Creek Farm exists at such an abnormally high standard that recreating its features would be a challenge even with unlimited time and resources. The backbone of the tract is two creeks that stretch for approximately one mile each through the interior of the property before converging in the southwest corner. These major wildlife corridors complemented by vast hillsides of pristine upland hardwoods, broad hardwood bottom areas with large clearings and dense thickets, and several unthinned lobolly pine stands. The gently rolling crop fields place an aesthetically pleasing finishing touch to the farm as well. The local deer and turkey populations are truly thriving and the layout of the big field (25+/- acres) has a very appealing set up to plant for doves.

Located 5+/- miles from the Broad River and Lake Monticello, 50+/- minutes from Columbia, 1.5 hours from Greenville, and just over an hour from Charlotte

















Another advantage is an existing crop lease agreement that would allow the fields to be planted with food sources on an annual basis.

Wild turkey numbers have remained strong on Beaver Creek Farm during the current fifteen year decline throughout South Carolina and the lay of the land fosters a legitimate scenario for growing and holding trophy whitetails. The potential to implement an exceptional dove field cannot be emphasized enough and a population of wild quail resides on the property as well. Beaver Creek Farm is truly an extraordinary piece of ground ideal for the avid hunter."
