TRACT 15 FIELDNOTE DESCRIPTION OF 10.080 ACRES I. D. THOMAS SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 74 POLK COUNTY, TEXAS

BEING 10.080 acres, more or less, located in the I. D. Thomas Survey, Abstract No. 74 in Polk County, Texas, being part of the called 201.863 acre tract described in a Deed from Copper Station Holdings, LLC to Lee Brown Sterling, Jr., Trustee dated June 9, 2006 and recorded in Volume 1513, Page 327 of the Official Public Records of Polk County, Texas and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1/2-nch iron rod set in the northeasterly margin of a graded public road, known locally as Ollie Loop Road, (40 foot wide right of way) for the westerly common corner of the herein described 10.080 acre tract and a 10.012 acre tract created this same day. From said corner, a 1/2-inch iron rod found in the center of the said road for the most northwesterly corner of the said 201.863 acre tract bears N 14° 26' 10" W 990.81 feet:

THENCE N 76° 49' 46" E 903.91 feet with the common line of the said 10.080 acre tract and the said 10.012 acre tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for the easterly common corner of the said 10.080 acre tract and the said 10.012 acre tract in the westerly line of a 10.159 acre tract created this same day;

THENCE S 20° 33' 49" E 241.00 feet with the common line of the said 10.080 acre tract and the said 10.159 acre tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for the easterly common corner of the said 10.080 acre tract and the said 10.312 acre tract;

THENCE S 51° 37' 15" W 1036.40 feet with the common line of the said 10.080 acre tract and the said 10.312 acre tract to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for the westerly common corner of the said 10.080 acre tract and the said 10.312 acre tract in the northeasterly margin of the said road;

THENCE along the northeasterly margin of the said road and with a curve to the right (having a radius of 220.00 feet, a central angle of 55° 10′ 38″, and a long chord of N 26° 24′ 48″ W 203.77 feet) 211.86 feet to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for the end of the said curve:

THENCE N 02° 21' 19" W 225.43 feet continuing along the northeasterly margin of the said road to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for an angle corner;

THENCE N 01° 15' 21" W 45.41 feet continuing along the northeasterly margin of the said road to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for an angle corner;

THENCE N 08° 12' 23" W 110.66 feet continuing along the northeasterly margin of the said road to a 1/2-inch iron rod set for an angle corner;

THENCE N 19° 31' 34" W 106.61 feet continuing along the northeasterly margin of the said road to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, and containing 10.080 acres, more or less, as shown on the accompanying plat of even date herewith.
