COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS

RESUBDIVISION OF LOT 13 BOXLEY ESTATES

- 1. The covenants and restrictions governing Boxley Estates shall remain in effect and be supplemented by these covenants and restrictions. Resorted See Allache & A
- 2. The road maintenance agreement shall apply to all lot owners as specified in the Boxley Estates covenants and restrictions. See attached # B
- 2. No livestock or exotic animals are to be kept on these properties. No dog kennels will be allowed and no pets will be kept outside the house unless fenced or leashed.
- 3. No trees over 6" will be cut and no areas will be clear-cut without approval of the Proprietor. Additionally, no areas within 25' of property lines will be cut in order to maintain privacy between lots.
- 5. Outbuildings, structures and fencing must be approved Proprietor and shall not be constructed with-in 25' of the property line.
- 6. No satellite receiving equipment over 30" in diameter shall be installed any where on Boxley Lot 13 resubdivision.
- 7. All electric lines, telephone lines, cable television lines and water piping shall be buried as required by Buckingham county ordinance but at minimum 18" below ground level.
- 8. Hunting shall be allowed by land owners and guests but no hunt clubs shall operate within Boxley Lot 13 resubdivision.
- 9. Use of all motor vehicles including off road (all terrain) vehicles will be restricted to those private raods maintained under the Boxley Estates road maintenace agreement.
