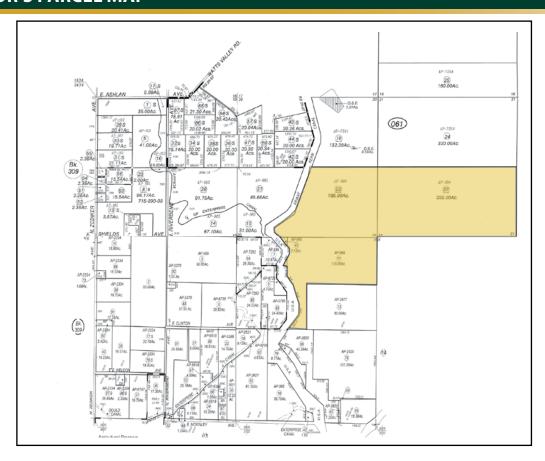

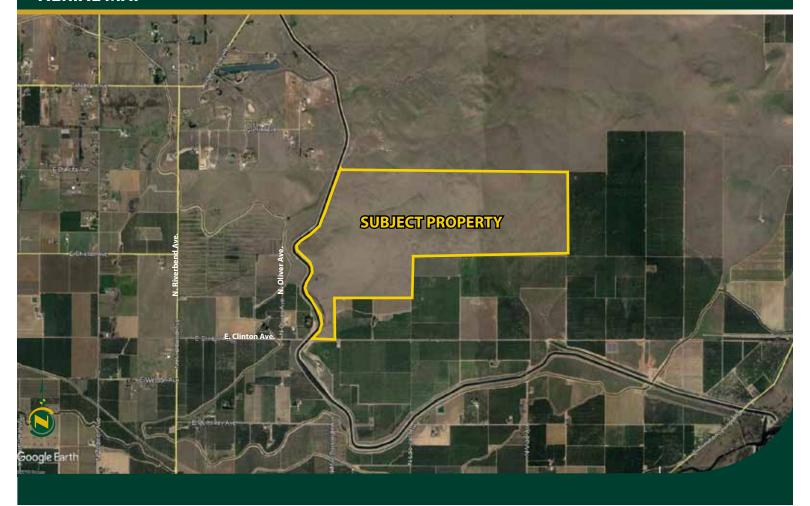

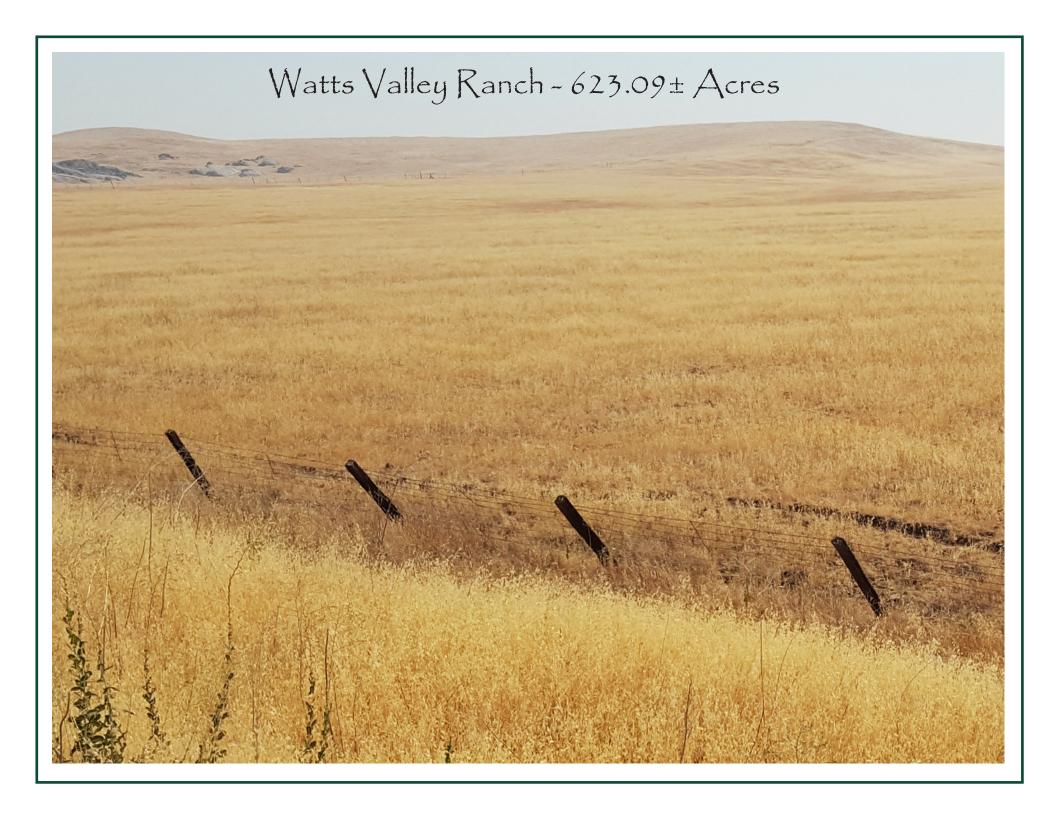

#### **ASSESSOR'S PARCEL MAP**



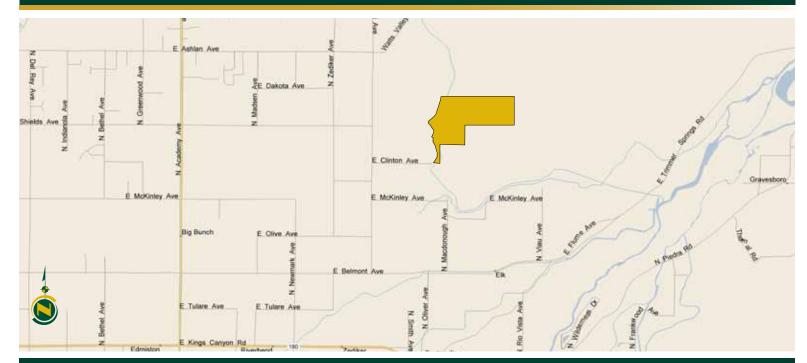
#### **AERIAL MAP**
