





RE: Septic site evaluation/soils due diligence for Alt. Key #3848801 Bonsmara Dr, Groveland, FL 34736_lot 50, Clearwater Reserve Phase I

Mr. Pierce

Following is a summary of our findings along the soil boring sites that you have requested and we have performed on August 23, 2019

- Expect minor limitations regarding seasonal high water table elevation concerning septic system. As I mentioned to you in the field, expect a shallow/filled septic system approximately 6-12" above current grade where I dug the holes.
- The drainfield location would be on the left of the house and towards the rear if you're standing on Bonsmara Drive looking at the future home.
- A potable well would have to meet 75 ft from any part of the septic system, and therefore anywhere on the right hand side towards front (or rear) would give you a good well location which would also ensure that the well is on higher ground than the septic.
- There where no restrictive soils within the soil borings that would require an excavation (such as muck, peat, etc).
- Careful planning of future home should take into account potable well placement, septic
 placement and slope/grading to ensure proper surface drainage of the lot due to its
 slope.

Notes:

- This is a general soil analysis, and it should not be used for site specific septic
 permitting and installation. For assistance with septic system design and installation at

- The soil borings were performed where it would be feasible/sensible for a future septic but there was no indication as to where the future home will be built and therefore this is not a formal soil analysis for a future septic system.
- This due diligence letter is accurate for 18 months and according to the provisos listed above.
