This Survey Is Based On Found Monuments Of A "1958" Re-Survey Of The "THOMAS PLACER CLAIM", M.S. No. By Kenneth L. Preston, P.E. 1153.

My Survey Was Perpetrated To Re-establish And Monument A Portion Of The Idaho County Road Right-Of-Way Which Was Condemned Feb. 27, 1913.

The Primary Calls Of The Condemnation Description Do Not Match The Secondary Calls Of Bearings & Distances Therefore I Had To Make A 11.39' Adjustment In 1,056' Of Traverse, Using The "Compos Rule" To Bring Condemnation Description Centerline Back Onto The Boundary Of The Mining Claim.
