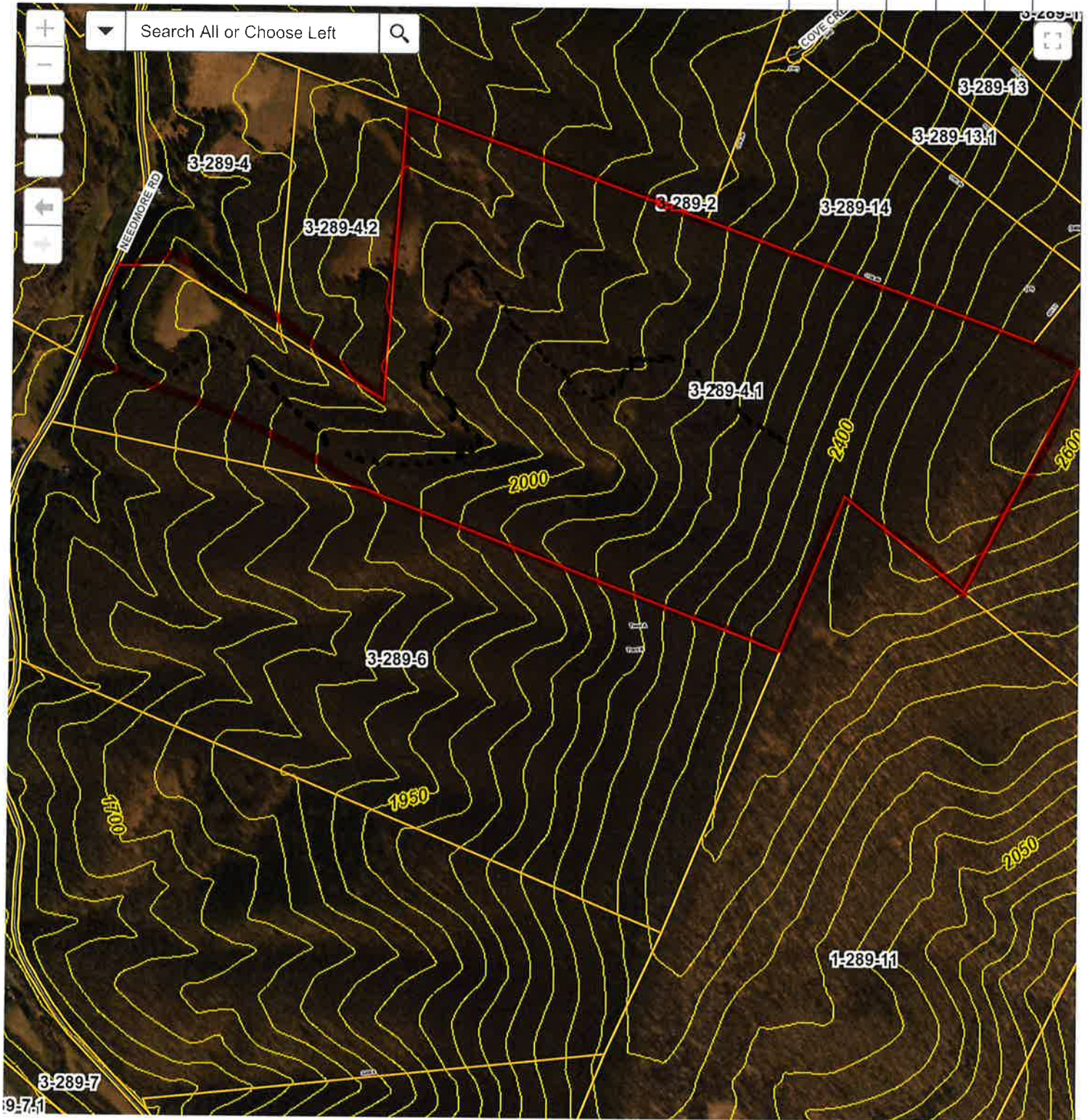

SURVEY DESCRIPTION OF DONNA JEAN TEETS 117.2 ACRE TRACT, MORE OR LESS, WHICH DEED IS RECORDED IN DEED BOOK 202 AT PAGE 774, IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF HARDY COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA

" Beginning at No. 1 on the attached plat a marked White Oak in the mouth of a small hollow where a Stone was called for in the description of the 159 acre tract, of which this is a part; thence, with the southeast bounds of State Route No. 8 N 30 00' 00" E 472 feet to No. 2 a 5/8" re-bar in the fence line and corner to Karen and Donald Swisher; thence, with their line, S 84 35' 00" E 345 feet to No. 3 a 5/8" Re-bar set on a slope at the edge of the cleared land; thence, S 50 00' 00" E passing Swisher's corner a 5/8" Re-bar at 594 feet and continuing in all 1261 feet to ^{No. 4} a 5/8" Re-bar and corner to Fogle ' 17.057 acre tract; thence, with a line of the last named tract, N 16 45' 00" E 1270 feet to No. 5 a 5/8" Re-bar set about 2 poles north of a wire fence, corner to Fogle and in the original line of the 159 acre tract; thence, up the mountain with the original line, S 61 10' 00" E 3066 feet to No. 6 a Stonepile on the top of the mountain, near the west brow in a line of Davis Brothers; thence,

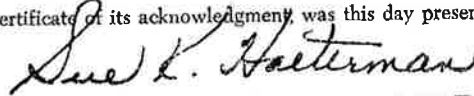
with Davis line, S 47 30' 00" W 140.25' to No. 7 a fallen Pine (now a Stonepile)
thence, S 42 00' 00" W 226.7 feet to No. 8 a Chestnut Oak standing about 2
feet from the east corner of a large Rock; thence, S 35 15' 00" W 320 feet to
No. 9 small Shelly Ledge; thence, S 32 10' 00" W 412 feet to No. 10 a Stonepile
with 2 White Oaks marked as pointers on the southwest slope and corner to
Davis' Willis Tract; thence, with a line of the same, N 43 30' 00" W 445.5
feet to two small Stonepiles (formerly two Pines) and No. 11 on the plat
thence with part of another
Willis line S 29 00' 00" W 610.5 feet to No. 12 a Stonepile 8 feet northeast of
Chestnut Oak blazed as a center line; thence, N 60 25' 53" W 3758 feet to
the beginning, containing 117.2 acres, more or less".
