Salinas Valley

The Salinas Valley is an agriculturally rich valley that runs inland from California's Monterey Bay.

Fertile alluvium derived soils, coastal influenced climate, and efficient agricultural growing practices provide the foundation for its recognition as the "Salad Bowl of the World".

The valley is at the heart of Monterey County's \$4.4 Billion agricultural industry and one of the most productive valleys in the United States for lettuce, strawberries, broccoli and other fresh vegetable crops.



Location

The Carl M. Nielsen Ranch is located on the east side of the valley, approximately half way between Salinas and Chualar.

This is a highly productive region of the Salinas Valley that has a cool coastal climate suitable for a variety of fresh vegetables and strawberries; well-drained soils suitable for spring, summer and fall crops; and at a location that is within close proximity to Salinas' shipping, cooling and processing facilities.

Residential Parcel

The residential parcel is located at the northeast corner of the ranch and is a separate 1-acre legal lot that is accessed by a 40-foot right-of-way to Old Stage Road. The parcel is improved with a 1,835-square foot* dwelling that provides an opportunity for additional income or employee housing.

Water

Located within the Eastside Aquifer Subbasin of the Salinas Valley Groundwater Basin, the ranch is removed from the salt water intrusion occurring closer to the Monterey Bay.

Irrigation water is provided by two wells, one of which has a 300-horsepower pump with a variable frequency drive. Water is distributed to the fields by high pressure pipelines. Domestic water is provided by one well.

Well and water quality reports are available with a signed NDA.

Chualar loam (CbA) is commonly found throughout the east side of the Salinas Valley and is the predominate soil on the Carl M. Nielsen Ranch. This is a level, very deep, well-drained soil that is rated Prime/Class 1 by the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

In this area, the soil is intensively farmed for head lettuce, leaf lettuce, broccoli and strawberries.
