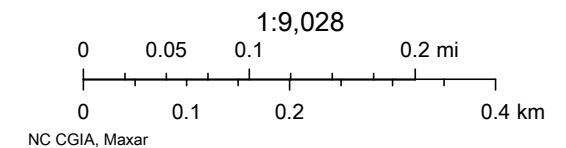
Boundary Stream, Intermittent River/Creek Water Body
