

WATER:


The property has access to Consolidated I.D. ditch water in addition to 2 domestic groundwater wells consisting of a 5 HP pump and a 10 HP pump.

DhA = Delhi loamy sand, 0-3% slopes, MLRA 17


Hg = Dello loamy sand
