

A 34.02 acre tract, lying and being situated in the ANTONIO DEL RIOS SURVEY, A-26, Madison County, Texas, and being the called 34.11 acre tract described in the deed from Willie Mae Upchurch, a widow, to George I. Terrell and wife, Florence V. Terrell, as recorded in Volume 182, Page 112, of the Deed Records of Madison County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the petrified wood rock found at the Northeast corner of the beforementioned 34.11 acre tract, said rock being adjacent to a fence;

THENCE South 09° 03' 22" West along the East line of the beforementioned 34.11 acre tract, adjacent to a fence, for a distance of 2093.95 feet to a petrified wood rock found marking the Southeast corner of the said 34.11 acre tract;

THENCE North 81° 21' 38" West along the South line of the beforementioned 34.11 acre tract, partially adjacent to a fence, for a distance of 707.65 feet to an iron rod set for corner at the Southwest corner of the said 34.11 acre tract;

THENCE North 09° 03' 22" East along the West line of the beforementioned 34.11 acre tract, at a distance of 2068.83 feet, pass an iron rod found in the fence found marking the South line of a county road (Union Road), continue on for a total distance of 2093.95 feet and corner in the centerline of said county road at the Northwest corner of said 34.11 acre tract:

THENCE South 81° 21' 38" East along the North line of the beforementioned 34.11 acre tract, same being adjacent to the centerline of said county road, for a distance of 707.65 feet to the PLACE OF BEGINNING, containing 34.02 acres of land, more or less, as surveyed in January 1983 by S.
