UTILITIES:

Water-Pecos County Fresh Water, P.O. Box 535, Imperial, TX 79743, 223 W. FM 11 (In the Imperial Public Library Building) 432-536-2236, pecoscountyfreshwater@yahoo.com. Contract must be signed. \$350.00 New Connection Fee or \$150.00 New Service Fee depending on type of connection. One way valve must be inserted on customer's side. PCFW will insert valve when inserting meter for cost of valve. Ask about Autopay drafting.

Trash-Collected weekly by the City of Fort Stockton. Customers in Imperial, Coyanosa and along route: Rollout containers are available for \$35.00 + tax per month and are collected on Thursdays. Commercial dumpsters are \$106.50 + tax per month and are collected on Thursdays. Sign up can be done at Pecos County Fresh Water above.

General Directions for obtaining electrical service:

- Obtain a 911 address if you do not have one. (See "ADDRESSES" below)
- Call Oncor at 1-888-313-4747, 1-888-313-6862, for accounts in their areas (inside town of Imperial), or AEP Texas at 1-877-373-4858 for accounts in their areas (adjacent to FM 1053 & FM 11) and request an ESID number. They will tell you that you must have a utility pole with a meter base installed if you do not currently have one. Sometimes it takes 24 to 48 hours for them to get your address in the system if it is a new address. (When trying to obtain an ESID number from Oncor or AEP, it is vital that you tell them your address but qualify that on Oncor's system, instead of Imperial, the address is listed as Monahans. For AEP areas along Hwy. 1053 and 11, the address is listed as McCamey Oil Field (Including Border Rd.). Some areas further out are Imperial Oil Field.
- Once your address is in the system and you have an ESID number and your pole and meter base are set up, you can call the electric company and give them your ESID number and they will schedule hook-up. This process can take weeks or months, so start the process early.
