The undersigned being all of the Petitioners and Respondents in the abovecaptioned proceeding do hereby make and enter into the following Consent Order for the division of the remaining farm property formerly owned by Robert Black and do hereby stipulate and consent to the following:

Findings of Fact:

1. This special proceeding was originally commenced on July 6, 2012 to



partition the Robert Black homeplace consisting of the original 154.736 acres, more or less, conveyed to his children Lillie M. Black, Ethel B. Wilkerson, Walter C. Black, William M. Black, Ila B. Harris, James T. Black, Alma B. Rollins, and Johnnie M. Black according to that certain deed dated the 31st day of March, 1987, and of record in Deed Book 263 at Page 695 in the office of the Register of Deeds of Granville County.

- 2. From this property previously described in the parties' petition have been conveyed the following parcels:
 - a. A one (1) acre parcel to William M. Black of record in Deed Book
 158, Page 300, Granville County Registry.
 - b. A tract containing one (1) acre, more or less, conveyed to Archie T.
 Wilkerson and Ethel L. Wilkerson of record in Deed Book 184 at
 Page 277, Granville County Registry.
 - A tract of 1.05 acres, more or less, conveyed to Johnnie M. Black of record in Deed Book 213, Page 551, Granville County Registry.
 - d. A tract conveying one (1) acre and the Robert C. Black homeplace to
 Lillie M. Black of record in Deed Book 263, Page 693, Granville
 County Registry. This lot and homeplace was deeded to William M.
 Black in Deed Book 1210, Page 410, Granville County Registry.
 - e. A 1.096 acre deeded easement for subdivision access to Sidney L.
 Dean of record in Deed Book 868, Page 1568, Granville County
 Registry.
 - f. A 1.08 acre lot to Tiffany Wilkerson of record in Deed Book 894,
 Page 162, Granville County Registry.

- 3. Upon the filing of the special proceeding, a division of the property was complicated by the conveyance of certain of the lots noted above to family members and also by the lack of funds to survey the property and to fund compensation for Commissioners and other expenses of the proceeding.
- 4. Subsequent to the filing of this proceeding Lillie Mae Black died intestate on November 5, 2011.
- 5. At the time of her death, Lillie Mae Black had been a long-term recipient of Medicaid benefits with a resulting Medicaid lien exceeding \$12,088.86, which constitutes a known lien upon the real estate subject to division or sale. As a result of the known and unknown debts and claims against the estate and the minimal personal assets, T. S. Royster, Jr., appeared as the Public Administrator for the Estate of Lillie Mae Black.
- 6. Pursuant to the Order of sale entered by the Court on July 6, 2012, John W. Watson, Jr. and T. S. Royster, Jr. as co-commissions conducted a public sale of a 70 acre parcel for \$108,920.77 leaving a net sum of \$94,191.18 for distribution and to further fund survey costs and other expenses associated with the division.
- 7. By Order dated October 25, 2012, Herbert Morton, Jr, registered land surveyor was appointed and completed a proposed land division taking into account the parcels previously received by individual family members, roadaccess and acreage. A copy of said plat is attached hereto as Exhibit I.
- 8. Prior to consenting to the division prepared by Herbert Morton, Jr. surveyor, various parties have requested soil testing to determine suitability for onsite waste disposal i.e. septic tank. Pursuant to the July 11, 2013 Order of the

- Superior State Court, Daniel L. Bliley soil scientist completed soil testing as requested by family members. This testing shows suitable soils for the lots in question. A copy of the soil testing map is attached hereto Exhibit II.
- 9. In addition to the lots designated for the Petitioners and Respondents, Lot 6 was preserved for sale to fully satisfy the Medicaid lien and other costs of the administration of the Estate of Lillie Mae Black.
- 10. Because Lots 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 do not immediately adjoin the public right-of-way of Range Road NC SR 1126, the property division reserves a 60' right-of-way to serve these interior lots. From the retained proceeds of the Special Proceeding, the parties agree that a 20 foot drive shall be graded and graveled for immediate ingress and egress to these lots.
- 11. Subject to these provisions, the undersigned confirm the actual partition of the lots as shown on the preliminary map by Herbert Morton Jr., registered land surveyor.

By and with the consent of the parties, the Court makes the following:

Conclusions of Law:

- 1. The actual partition of the property as shown by the preliminary plat prepared by Herbert Morton Jr. land surveyor is fair, reasonable and agreeable to all parties.
- The public sale of Lot 6 is necessary to fully satisfy the creditors and claims, including Medicaid, against the Estate of Lillie Mae Black.
- 3. The owners of the interior Lots 10 14 require access to the public right-ofway of Range Road NC SR 1126. Construction of the private 20 foot road for service to these lots is essential for a fair and equitable division.

BASED UPON the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and with the consent of all parties, it is therefore ordered as follows:

 The actual division of the parties' property based upon the preliminary division prepared by Herbert Morton, Jr. is hereby approved:

Lots 1, 12, 14 Johnnie Melvin Black Lots 2, 16 Ethel Black Wilkerson William McKinley Black Lots 3, 19 Lot 4, 13, 18, 21 James T. Black, Ricardo J. Black, Martin L. Black and Katherine C. Black Alma Black Rollins Lot 5, 11, 17, 20 Lots 7, 8, 9, 10 Walter Black, Jr., Pamela A. Williams, Marilyn Black Struzziery and Marietta Black (heirs of Walter Black, Sr.) Lot 15 Ila Black Harris (Widow) Estate of Lillie Mae Black Lot 6

- Herbert Morton, Jr. registered land surveyor is hereby appointed and authorized to complete the ground survey of the parties' lots to include a 60 foot private road access serving the interior lots 10 - 14.
- 3. With the consent of the parties, the Court further directs that the costs for the construction of a 20 foot gravel drive shall be paid as a cost of the division for immediate access by those owners.
- 4. T. S. Royster, Jr. as Public Administrator of the Estate of Lillie Mae Black is hereby authorized to sell that certain lot designated as Lot 6 at public auction as a judicial sale, after advertising the same according to law, with proceeds therefrom to be held by such Administrator and used in the administration of the decedents estate according to law.

- 5. Upon the confirmation of this <u>division</u>, the Clerk of Court shall approve the costs including Commissioners' fees and attorneys' fees.
- 6. This judgment along with the completed survey shall be recorded in the Register of Deeds of Granville County and shall constitute a final division of such property and shall effect a transfer of title to the various lots as if the parties had executed partition deeds.
- 7. The funds held by the court commissioners, after payment of all costs, shall be distributed to the tenants in common as their interests appear. The commissioner shall file an accounting of such distribution with the Clerk of Superior Court.
