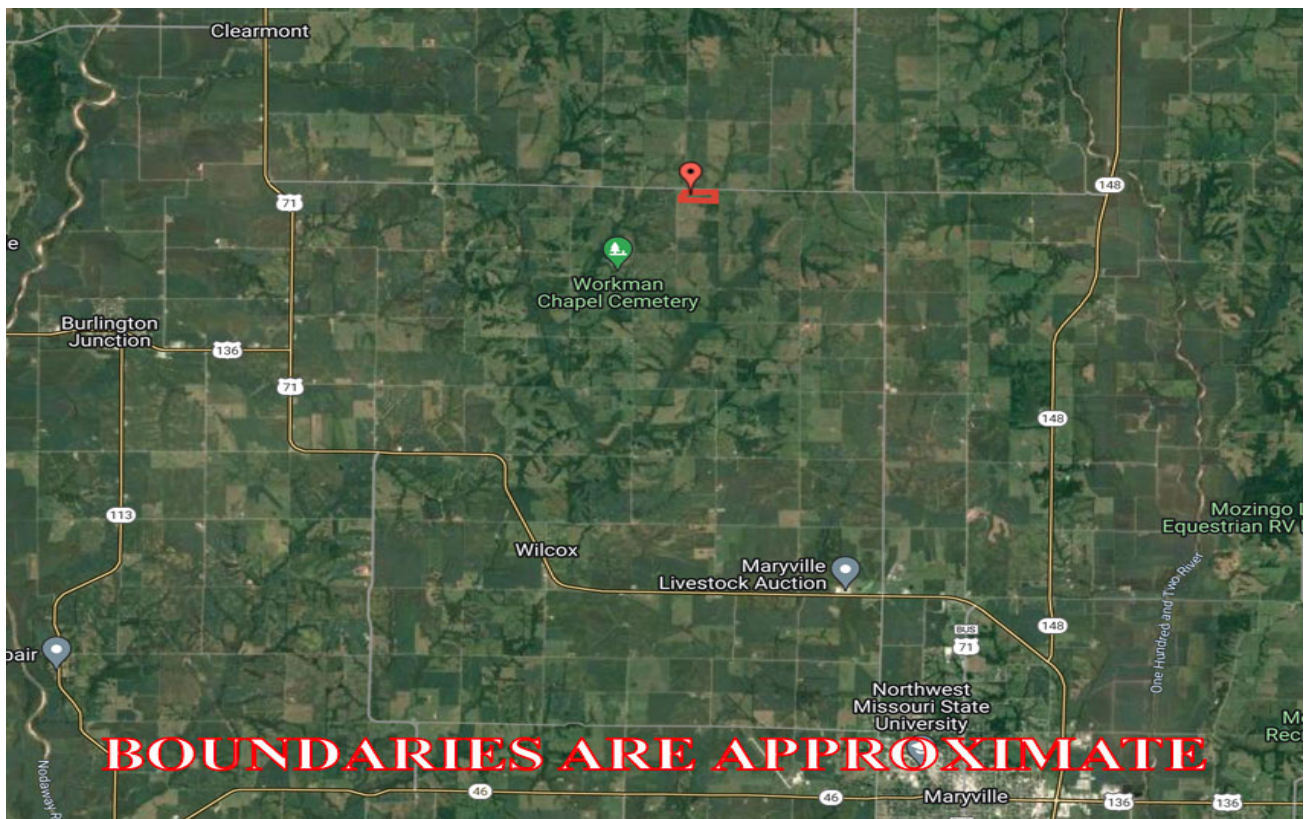

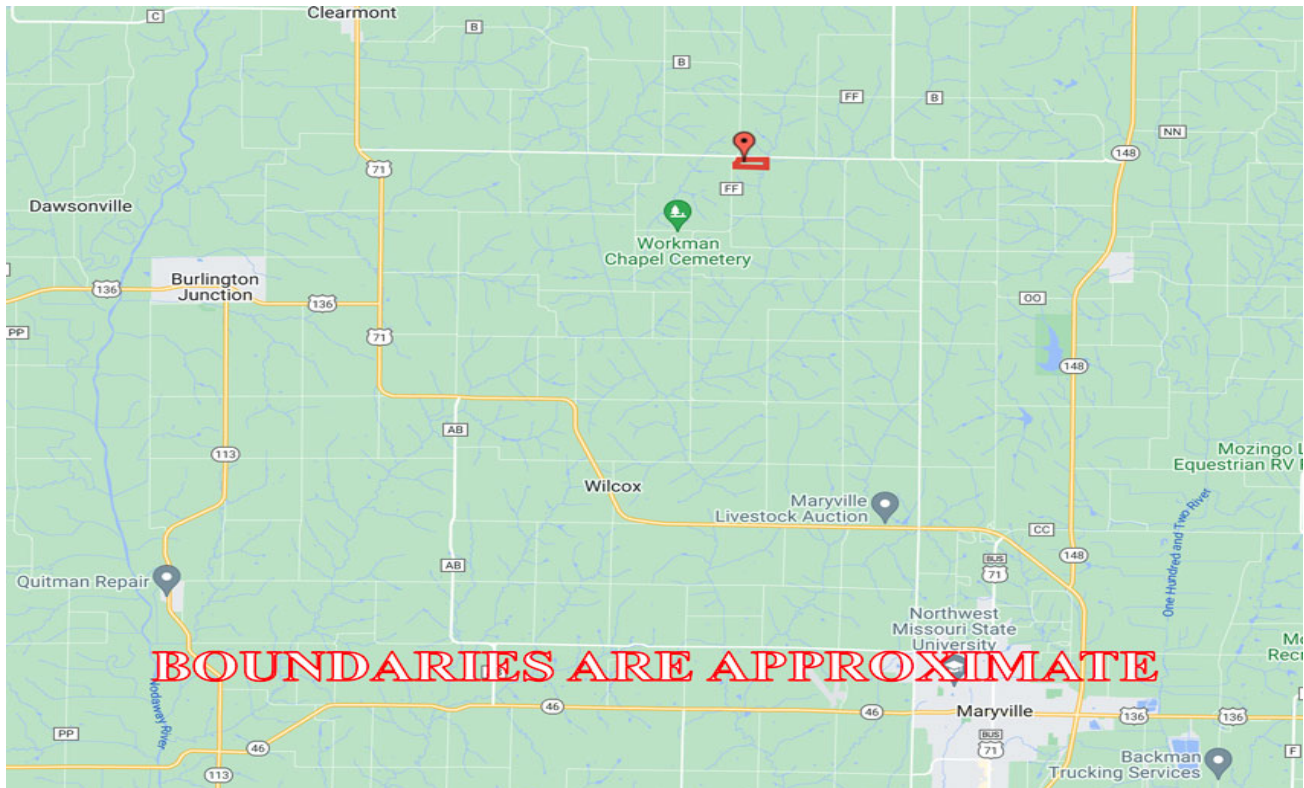
General Location Map



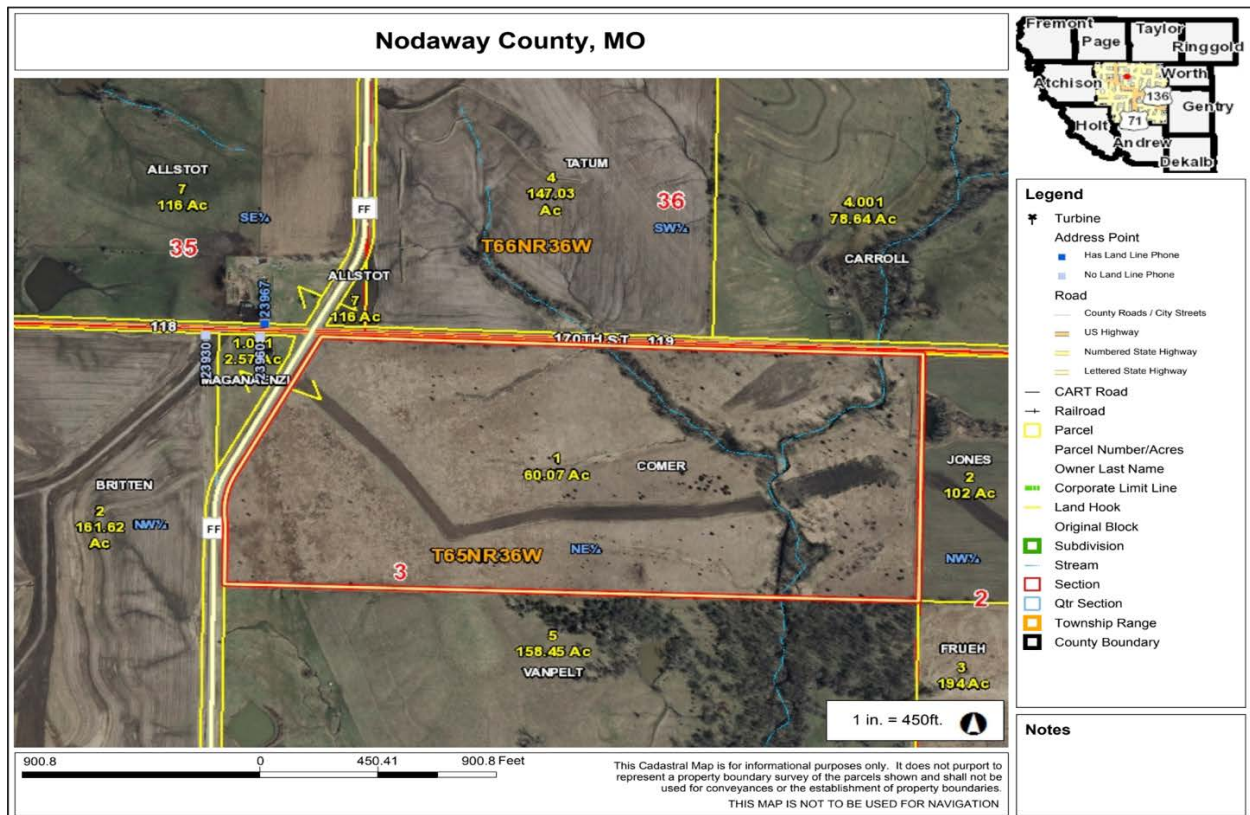

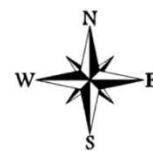

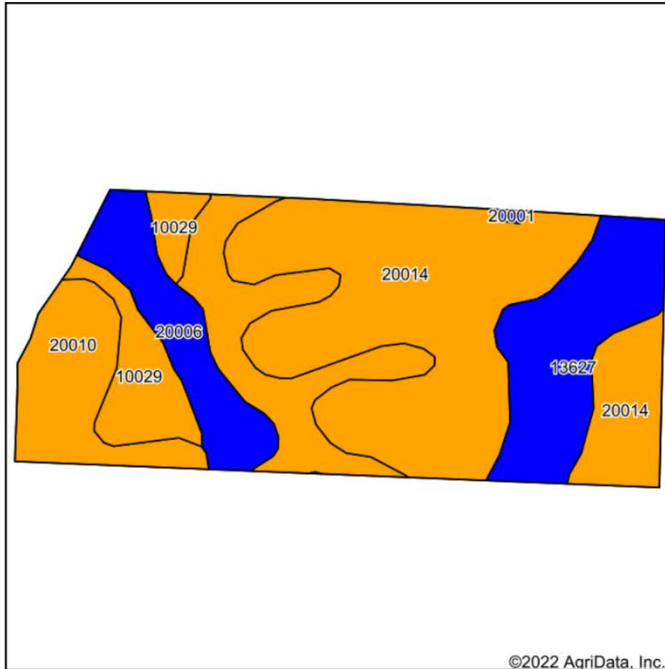

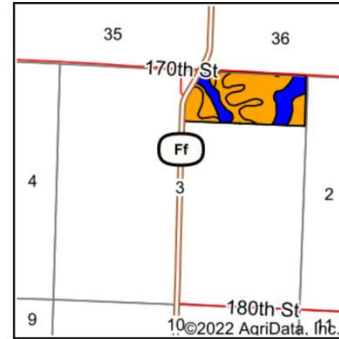

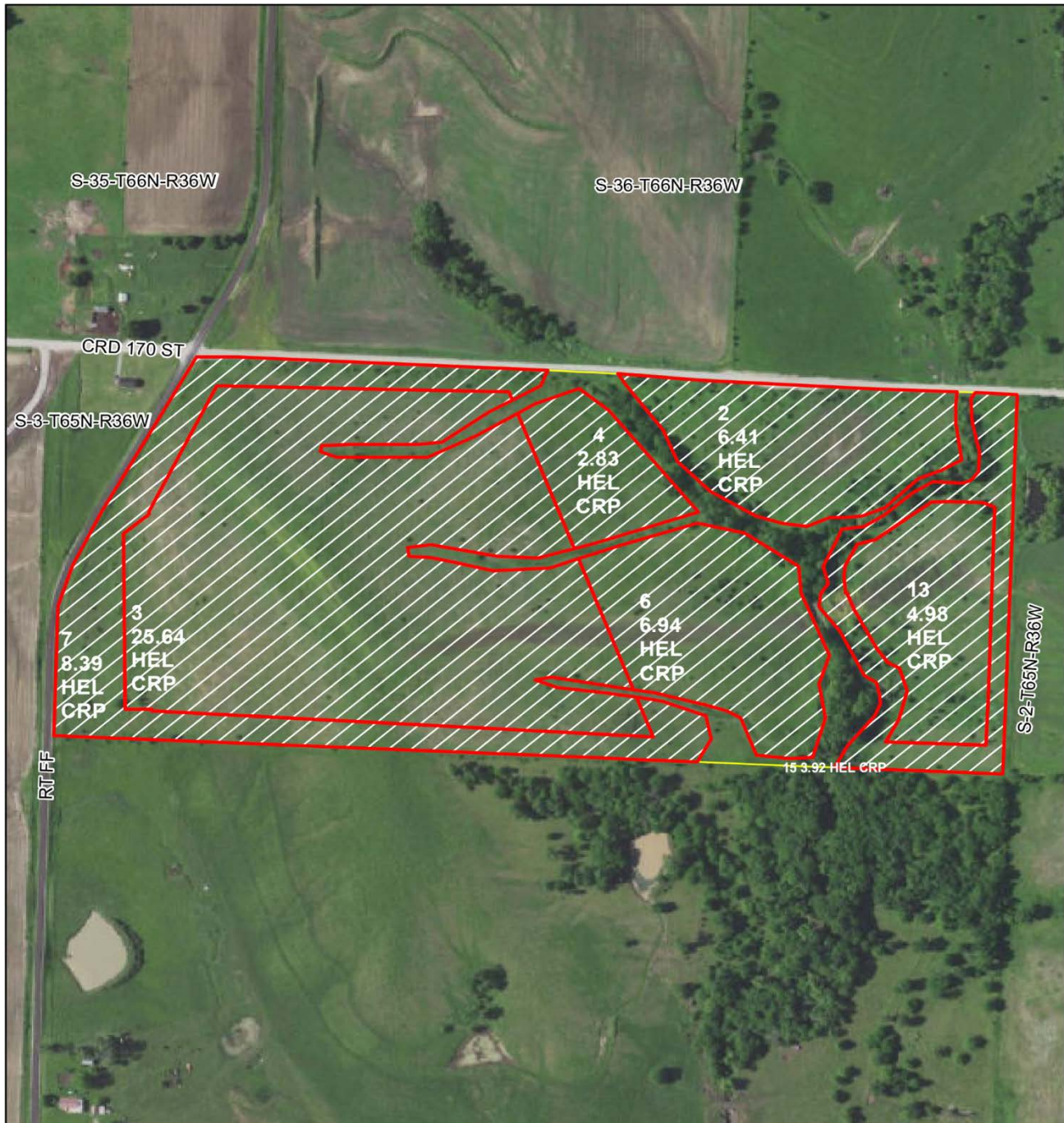
