Bylaws

The Oxbow Estates Property Owners Association A Texas Nonprofit Corporation

Article I - Name

The name of the association is Oxbow Estates Property Association hereafter referred to as The Association. It is a nonprofit organization as chartered and further described in the Certificate of Formation filed as Document Number 242858010002 with the Secretary of State of Texas on January 14, 2009.

Article II - Purpose

The purpose of the Association is:

- A. To represent the common interests of the property owners in the maintenance of Oxbow Trail, the primary road of Oxbow Estates, a subdivision in Burnet County, Texas hereinafter referred to as The Subdivision;
- B. To represent the common interest of property owners in determination of continuance of maintenance of the road or the assumption of maintenance by the county of Burnet, Texas;
- B. To represent the common interests of the property owners in the safety and security of the Subdivision;
- C. To represent the property owners in any other matters of common interest among the members of The Association when and as defined by the members and amended to these bylaws.

The order of precedence of the Association's governing documents is: Plat & Map deed restriction; Restrictive Covenants deed restriction; Articles of Incorporation/Certificate of Formation; and Bylaws.

Article III- Members

Section1. Members.

Members are the lot owners as defined in the Restrictive Covenants. These are Owners of property in The Subdivision and those owners of property fronting on Oxbow Trail annexed by The Subdivision.

Section 2. Dues and Assessments.

Dues and assessments shall be collected by the POA by lot for the purposes stated in Article II as determined by the Board of Directors and set annually. Initial dues are set at \$600 and are capped to increase no more than 5% per year unless otherwise voted on by the membership. Special assessments shall be set by the Board of Directors for other purposes as determined by actions approved by vote of members in attendance at an annual or special meeting of the full membership, as set forth in Article VI, Sections 4 and 5. The Association fiscal year shall be January 1st through December 31st.

Section 3. Delinquency of Dues.

Dues, assessments or fees shall be delinquent 90 days after they are due. The board may create a separate collection policy, and if so, shall provide it to the members at least 30 days prior to the beginning of the fiscal year in which it shall take effect.

Section 4. Voting.

Members shall be entitled to one vote per lot at meetings. Voting can be by mail-in, e-mail or other electronic method as defined by current business practices. Voting quorums and majorities are defined in separate applicable paragraphs that follow.

Article IV - Officers

Section 1. Composition.

The elected officers of The Association shall be a president, a vice-president, a secretary and a treasurer. Up to two additional officers may be appointed by the board of directors to assist the elected officers in their duties. If there are appointed officers, they shall be known as assistant secretaries for (purpose). Officers are ex-officio, members of the board of directors.

Section 2. Duties.

The officers shall perform the duties prescribed in this section and such others as allowed by The Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws of The Association or the parliamentary authority adopted by The Association. They shall be granted reimbursement for any expenses as approved by the board of directors for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

Section 2.1. President. The president shall be the chief executive officer of The Association, and shall serve as chairman of the board of directors; have general supervision of the affairs of The Association; have power to appoint special committees subject to the approval of the board of directors; be responsible for maintaining good public relations with the community being the official spokesperson of The Association; and be ex-officio a member of committees.

Section 2.2. Vice President. The vice-president shall assume the duties of president in the absence of the president, and shall assist the president in his/her efforts for the good of the organization.

Section 2.3. Secretary. The secretary shall record and maintain minutes of The Association, assist the President with correspondence and maintain the non-financial files of The Association. The secretary shall be responsible for sending notices of meetings and other notifications as directed by the board of directors. The secretary shall have custody of the corporate seal if there shall be one.

Section 2.4. Treasurer. The treasurer shall have charge of the collection of dues and assessments, and for receipt and deposit of income into accounts at such banks and financial institutions as directed by the board of directors. The treasurer shall make payments and withdrawals for obligations of The Association in accordance with the corporate resolutions established with The Association's banks and institutions. The treasurer shall keep records of monies received and expended and shall make financial reports at meetings. At the end of the fiscal year the treasure shall file required tax and corporate reports with state and federal agencies as required by governing corporate laws.

Section 3. Term of Office.

The officers of The Association shall be elected by a vote of the membership for a term of three years and can serve for no more than three consecutive terms. Members can be elected to another position consecutively after serving their terms in their previously elected or appointed position. Members, who have served full consecutive terms as prescribed above, also can be reelected to their same previously held position after one full term of that position has passed. A term is considered to start effective upon adjournment of the meeting at which the vote was held and complete one year after.

Section 4. Vacancies.

Vacancies among the officers shall be filled by appointment by the board of directors for the remainder of the term vacated.

Article V - Board of Directors

Section 1. Composition.

The board of directors shall consist of the elected and appointed officers and three at large directors elected by the membership.

Section 2. Duties

The board of directors shall conduct the management and administration of The Association in all respects and for all purposes. The board of directors shall have the power to conduct the business of The Association except that which is retained by the membership as provided by these bylaws. Meetings of the board of directors shall be as provided in Article VI, Section 3.

Section 3. Officers of the Board.

The officers of the board are as provided in Article IV, Section2.

Section 4. Terms of Office.

- **Section 4.1. Officers.** The terms of office of the officers of the board are as provided in Article IV, Section 3.
- Section 4.2. At Large Directors. The at large directors of The Association shall be elected by a vote of the membership for a term of three years and can serve for no more than three consecutive terms. Initially, there shall be one at large director serving one year, a second director serving two years, and a third director serving three years. Thereafter, only one director shall be elected at the succeeding annual meeting for a full term of three years. Members, who have served full consecutive terms as prescribed above, also can be reelected to their same previously held position after one full term of that position has passed. A term is considered to start effective upon adjournment of the meeting at which the vote was held and complete one year after.

Section 5. Vacancies.

Vacancies among the at large directors shall be filled by appointment by the board of directors for the remainder of the term vacated.

Article VI – Meetings

Section 1. Association Regular Meetings.

- **Section 1.1. Frequency of Occurrence.** There shall be one general membership meeting per year. This meeting shall be known as the annual meeting for the purpose of electing officers and directors, receiving reports from officers, board of directors and committees and for any other business which shall properly come before the meeting. The meeting shall be scheduled to occur in the last quarter of The Association's fiscal year and upon any day decided upon by the president with approval from the board of directors.
- **Section 1.2 Agenda.** Subject to approval of the board, the president shall prepare the annual meeting agenda. Any member may request an item to be added to the agenda by submitting the item in writing to the board at least two weeks prior to the meeting. Members also may request additions to the agenda through motions at the meeting.
- **Section 1.3. Notification.** Notice of the annual meeting accompanied by the detailed agenda shall be sent to members at least 30 days prior to the date of the meeting.

Section2. Association Special Meetings.

- **Section 2.1. Occurrence.** Special meetings of the members of The Association shall be called by the president or by majority vote of the board as deemed necessary to address matters of The Association. Special meetings also shall be called by the board upon written request of one fourth or more of the members or upon an approved motion at the Annual or other convened member special meeting.
- **Section 2.2. Agenda.** Subject to approval of the board, the president shall prepare the special meeting agenda. Members may request additions to the agenda through motions at the meeting.

Section 2.3. Notification. Notice of the special meeting accompanied by the detailed agenda shall be sent to members at least two weeks prior to the date of the meeting.

Section 3. Board of Directors Meetings.

Board of directors meetings shall be held at least once per year at a time and place determined by the president. The president also shall call special meetings of the directors as required to determine specific courses of action in the disposition of matters approved by the general membership or as to be presented to the general membership.

Section 4. Quorum.

A quorum for association meetings shall be a simple majority of the members, except for meetings called for addressing amendments and actions committing financial liabilities, wherein the full membership shall be required. Such financial/amendment meetings can take place as virtual through electronic or certified mailing methods as though all members were present.

Section 5. Voting.

Motions for actions requiring financial commitments and liabilities as stated in Article VI Section 4 and Article III, Section 2, and including bylaws amendments shall require a two-thirds vote of the members. Members abstaining from voting shall be counted in the quorum. Voting shall be through casting a vote at a meeting or by mail-in or electronic ballot. All other measures shall require a simple majority of the quorum.

Article VII - Committees

Section 1. Formation.

The president, board of directors or assembly of membership may appoint standing or special committees as deemed necessary.

Section 2. Membership.

The chair shall be appointed at the time of formation of the committee. Membership may be modified by the chair upon notification to and approval by the president.

Section 3. Responsibilities.

Committees will address the purpose for which they are formed, record actions and minutes and report results to the board and/or the assembled membership as determined at the time of their appointment. A copy of critical notes, the minutes and reports shall be provided to The Association secretary for permanent filing.

Article VIII – Parliamentary Authority

The rules contained in the current edition of *Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised* shall govern The Association in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with these bylaws and any special rules The Association may adopt.

Article IX - Amendments

Section 1. Amendment Forums.

These bylaws may be amended at any annual, special or virtual meeting that utilizes mail-in or electronic ballot as though there was a meeting.

Section 2. Notification and Review.

Proposed amendments to these bylaws shall be provided to members at least 60 days prior to the identified meeting intended to discuss and vote on the proposed measures. Members shall submit their proposed revisions or comments to the board within 30 days after receipt and prior to the identified meeting date. The board shall disposition the comments and shall communicate their evaluations to the membership no later than two weeks before the identified meeting date. Proposed revisions will be discussed and voted upon as amendments.

Section 3. Voting.

Voting shall be as provided in Article VI, Section 5.

Section 4. Effectivity.

Unless otherwise provided prior to adoption or in the motion to adopt, an amendment shall become effective upon adjournment of the meeting at which it is adopted.

BURNET COUNTY SUBDIVISION AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1. INTRODUCTION

- 8. <u>Acceptance by Commissioners Court of Subdivision Streets built prior to April 24, 2000 for</u>
 County Maintenance and Public Subdivision streets subsequent to the date of this Order.
 - A. Main arterial roads within any subdivision established prior to April 24, 2000 must have been dedicated to the public.
 - B. All subdivisions affected under this section must reach fifty (50%) percent or greater occupancy and/or a constant daily minimum traffic count consistent with public safety as determined by the Precinct Commissioner.
 - C. Property owners, within the subdivision, or subdividers, affected by this section, shall donate all material costs needed to improve roads to meet county specifications as a method of acceptance of subdivision roads. County will provide labor and equipment.
 - D. Only the main arterial roads with a minimum 50 foot right-of-way (or an adequate right-of-way as deemed adequate by the Commissioners Court) in a subdivision will be considered for maintenance acceptance.
 - E. Request for acceptance as county roads, must be by written petition signed by a majority of the property owners and/or the authorized representative of the subdivision association and/or the governmental trustees or entity.
 - F. It shall be unlawful for Commissioners to maintain the streets and roads in any subdivision, and Burnet County will not accept or maintain said street and roads in any subdivision, unless and until such streets and roads have been constructed as specified in these regulations or regulations in effect at the time subdivision was established and the required utilities and drainage facilities have been installed, and such improvements have been accepted by order in writing by the Burnet County Commissioners Court in open session.

This certificate of formation is submitted for filing pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Business Organizations Code.

Article I - Entity Name and Type

The name and type of filing entity being formed are: Oxbow Estates Property Owners Association, a Texas nonprofit corporation (hereinafter "Corporation").

Article II - Purpose

Article X - Contracts or Transactions with Interested Directors, Officers and Members

This provision applies only to a contract or transaction between the Corporation and one or more of its directors or officers, or between the Corporation and an entity or other organization in which one or more of the Corporation's directors or officers is a managerial official or has a financial interest.

An otherwise valid contract or transaction is valid notwithstanding that a director, officer, or member of the Corporation is present at or participates in the meeting of the board of directors, of a committee of the board, or of the members that authorizes the contract or transaction, or votes to authorize the contract or transaction, if: (1) the material facts as to the relationship or interest and as to the contract or transaction are disclosed to or known by (a) the Corporation's board of directors, a committee of the board of directors, or the members, and the board, the committee, or the members in good faith and with ordinary care authorize the contract or transaction by the affirmative vote of the majority of the disinterested directors, committee members or members, regardless of whether the disinterested directors, committee members or members constitute a quorum; or (b) the members entitled to vote on the authorization of the contract or transaction, and the contract or transaction is specifically approved in good faith and with ordinary care by a vote of the members; or (2) the contract or transaction is fair to the Corporation when the contract or transaction is authorized, approved, or ratified by the board of directors, a committee of the board of directors, or the members. Common or interested directors or members of a Corporation may be included in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the board, a committee of the board, or members that authorizes the contract or transaction.

1. All lots shall be used for residential and home business purposes were

1. No tract shall ever be divided or sub-divided into AdRETHAN THREELOSS or tracts and any tract resulting therefrom shall contain NOT Jess THAN five acres and shall front on a dedicated street or road.

- 3. No lot shall be used, sold or conveyed as a public or private for ad or street other than to provide ingress and egress to and from tracts in this subdivision.
- 4. Only one single family dwelling and any accompanying out-buildings shall be erected or placed on any one lot. The same owner of two adjacent lots may combine them for building purposes.
- 5. Any residence constructed on a lot shall be of all new material and shall have a living area of not less than 1200 square feet exclusive of garages, carports and porches, and a minimum of 25 percent of the outside construction shall be of brick, stone or masonry. Such single family dwell ing shall not exceed two (2) stories in height.
- 6. No prefabricated, modular or mobile homes will be permitted on any int.
- 7. Any detached building, garage, carport, shed, barn or structure or addition to the residence must of all new material and he constructed in . workman like manner. Any variation from this restriction must have prior written approval of the Grantors.
- 8. Except for fences no buildings or structures of any nature shall be located closer than twenty-five feet to any property line. Variations from these requirements may be granted in individual cases where tract size or topography make these requirements impractical but any such variation must have the prior written approval of the Grantors.

- 7. Any dwelling commenced on the subject property shall be completed with reasonable diligence and in all events shall be completed as to like exterior within six months from the commencement of construction. We build the material of any kind shall be placed or stored on the subject property until the owner is ready to commence construction.
- 10. No trailer house, mobile home, camper, basement, tent, shack, karave, barn or other outbuilding shall be at any time used as a residence or dwelling, either temporarily or permanently.

- 16. Cars or other vehicles may not be stored on any tract in the area nor shall any car or vehicle that is not in running condition and regularly used be allowed on any tract for more than one week. No repairing of motor vehicles shall be permitted on any tract.
- 17. All buildings shall be equipped with approved sanitary plumbing fixtures and plumbing installation meeting the requirements of the National Plumbing Gode and shall have sewage disposal and water supply facilities meeting the requirements standards of the State of Texas and Burnet County.

Livestock with the exception of hogs and specifically including, but not limited to, horses and cattle, and also poultry may be raised, bred and kept on any tract, provided they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose. An FFA. 4-H club calf or lamb or similar project may be kept on the premises so long as same is not offensive to neighbors and is kept in a pen consistent with other improvements on the property specified herein. - 19. All fences constructed must be of new materials and be built in a professional manner. Fences constructed of wire must contain a minimum of five strands.
- 20. An easement ten feet in width adjacent to the property line and around the entire perimeter of the subject property is expressly reserved for the purposes of constructing and maintaining conduits, telephones, electric light poles, towers and other equipment to supply any public or private utility services.
- 21. No building shall be constructed on the property until provisions have been made for drainage of surface water to off site without drainage across adjacent property. Drainage shall be into the street or road area or into natural drainage areas.
- 22. The owners of the legal title of not lesss than 51% of the original lots in the subdivision may amend or extend these restrictions and the matters set forth herein by filing an instrument containing such amendment in the office of the County Clerk of Burnet County, Texas.
- 23. Without required to whether or not such are recited in conveyances or referred to in conveyances, these covenants, conditions and restrictions shall be deemed convenents running with the land and shall be binding upon Grantors, its or their successors or assigns, and all persons claiming under it or its successors or assigns, unless amended as herein provided for and filed of record in the Deed records of Burnet County, Texas,
- 24. In the event any of the restrictions set forth in these covenants are violated, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning a lot in Oxbow Development to prosecute any proceedings at law, or in equity, against persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenants, to either prevent him from doing so, or to recover damages for such violation.
- 25. These restrictions are covenants running with the land and shall be binding on all parties claiming under them until January 1, 2005 ar which time said restrictions shall automatically extend for successive periods of ten (10) years, unless amended as provided in Paragraph 22 hereof.

Oxbow Estates Property Owners Association Collection Policy

The Oxbow Estates Board of Directors has approved the following dues and assessments collection policy.

General:

All payments shall be made to Oxbow Estates POA, PO Box 556, Marble Falls, Texas 78654. An electronic payment method is preferred and is available by contacting the POA Treasurer. Payment by mailed check also is acceptable.

Annual Dues:

Lot Owners shall have the option to pay annual dues of \$600 in one or two payments. The first payment is due October 1st prior to the start of the POA's operating calendar year which is the immediately following January 1st. Owners can pay the complete year or half at that time. Should the lot owner choose to pay half with this first payment, a subsequent payment must be made no later than March 31st. Payment not received on October 1st shall be considered delinquent after 90 days and subject to accepted, standard business collection practices.

A missed October payment will be considered as half the annual dues for purposes of collection policy. After 90 days, this missed payment will accrue a late charge of \$30. If dues and late charge are not paid after an additional 20 days, the total amount due including the late charge shall be subject to an interest charge of 18% APR retroactive to January 1st. Should the past due amount including the late charge and interest along with the remaining half of the annual amount not be paid by March 31st, an additional \$30 late charge will be applied, and interest will continue to accrue on the balance due until payments are made in full.

An owner unable to pay in a timely manner can meet with the Board of Directors to demonstrate inability to pay to the stated schedule above. Such owner may be granted a method of assistance or other temporary arrangement until such time as all dues are back in good standing. Unless other arrangements are made, the account may be turned over to a collection agency.

Road Repair Assessment:

The primary method for paying the road repair costs is a loan secured from 1st United Bank of Marble Falls, Texas. In accordance with the loan Promissory Note of \$60,000, payments with interest are due the bank on the 1st of each month starting 30 days after the first draw. A special fee of \$71.85 assessed by lot shall be collected monthly to repay this road repair loan. The assessment shall be payable the 1st day of the month starting September 1, 2019. Assessments not paid within 20 days shall be considered delinquent and subject to accepted, standard business collection practices.

After 20 days, a missed payment will accrue a late charge of \$3. If the fee and late charge are not paid with the next subsequent payment(s), the total amount due including the late charges shall be subject to an interest charge of 18% APR retroactive to the 21st of the month in which the payment was due. Interest will continue to accrue until payments are made in full and the account is brought back to good standing.

A lot owner also has an option to pay their lot share of the road construction cost as a lump payment due immediately, or no later than October 15, 2019. No loan interest will need to be paid on lump payments. The lump payment will be based on the \$60,000 loan amount (\$3,000).

At the conclusion of work, and annually thereafter as appropriate, if total draws are less than \$60,000, and there are prepays reducing principal borrowed, then refunds or reduced payments would be calculated and passed back to the owners.

An owner unable to pay in a timely manner can meet with the Board of Directors to demonstrate inability to pay to the stated schedule above. Such owner may be granted a method of assistance or other temporary arrangement until such time all dues are back in good standing. Should past due amounts not be paid by 180 days and other arrangements not made, the account may be turned over to a collection agency.
