WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Thousand Five Hundred (\$15,500.00) Dollars, cash in hand paid, the receipt of all of which is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part does hereby grant and convey, with covenants of general warranty and to be free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, unto Donald E. McIntire all that certain tract or parcel of real estate containing 52 acres, more or less, together with all rights, rights of way, easements, minerals, oil and gas rights and appurtenances thereunto belonging, being and situate in Gore District of Hampshire County, West Virginia, being all the same tract or parcel of real estate which was conveyed " unto Hoy O. Baker by deed of R. V. Kaylor, John W. Walls and Ida A. Walls, dated 9 June, 1956, of record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Hampshire County, West Virginia, in Deed Book No. 133 at page 427, in which deed the real estate is more fully described according to a survey made by Paul S. Bradfield, surveyor, on 5 May, 1956, by metes and bounds as follows:

on top of a bluff of rocks, thence N. 33 E. 112 P. to a stone pile and some marked trees in a line of the original survey, thence leaving it and running across the entire tract N. 57 W. 61 P. to the beginning, containing 52 acres, more or less."
