
PROPERTY OVERVIEW

Apalachee Timberlands is a premier large acreage investment opportunity located in the Red Hills of North Florida. The property consists of roughly 1,000 acres with over 2 miles of frontage along US HWY 27 in Leon and Jefferson counties. The subject property is offered as a whole and is also offered in two parcels. The western parcel is approximately 490 acres and adjoins the St. Marks River Preserve State Park. The eastern parcel is approximately 522 acres and features paved road frontage on 3 sides. Both parcels are situated between the beautiful rolling quail woods of El Destino Plantation to the north and several thousand acres of conserved state lands to the south and west. The shared boundary with state lands could render a quality conservation easement opportunity.

The property location features convenient access to the shopping, dining, and healthcare of Tallahassee, FL while also providing the solitude and recreation of large acreage living. The adjoining State Park and additional neighboring state lands provide excellent wildlife corridor in addition to hiking, equestrian trails, and mountain bike paths. The property is also located just 30 miles north of the Gulf coast providing great access to coastal recreation throughout Florida's Big Bend region. There are numerous public access points to natural springs in the area for cooling off in the summer and the amenities of downtown Tallahassee are only 15 miles to the west. This property features incredible access to the amenities of a large city while preserving the privacy and natural living that you desire.
