DECLARATION OF RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS NEW RIVER HAVEN SUBDIVISION

- No campers nor motor homes may be placed on said lots, however, campers will be permitted on said lots during construction of a dwelling but in no event shall a camper / motor home remain on said lots for more than 12 months from date of settlement on purchase.
- 2. No junkyards shall be permitted on said lots. All vehicles shall have current state inspection vehicles.
- 3. No single wide or doublewide mobile homes shall be pennitted on said lots.
- 4. No outside privies (toilets) shall be permitted on said lots except during construction period for the construction crew only.
- No "on-frame" modular homes shall be permitted on said lots. All modular homes must meet or exceed the same codes and requirements as stick built homes.
- 6. Homes shall be a minimum of 1000 square feet heated floor space.
- No swine or poultry. Pets shall be penned or on leash or contained on the owner's property. Horses and/or ponies allowed East of Haven's Nest Lane as approved by the Homeowner's Association.
- 8. All river frontages will be required to be kept moved and clear of brush and debris.
- 9. No four-wheelers except on owner's property, not on common roads or common areas.
- Golf carts, all terrain vehicles such as Polaris Rangers, Kawasaki Mule, John Deere Gators, Yamaha Rhinos, etc. are allowed.
- 11. No Hunting of wildlife.
- 12. All property owners shall be members of the New River Haven Home Owners Association and shall abide by all regulations set forth by the Association.
- 13. The Homeowner's Association shall be formed within 60 days after auction.
- 14. Property line and interior fences shall be approved by the Homeowner's Association.
- 15. Owners of lots shall abide by all ordinances of Grayson County.
- 16. Lot owners will have the non-exclusive right to use the common area and will share the cost of maintenance, construction and repair with all other users who may have a right to use the common area. The grantor retains the right to use the common area for the benefit of the remaining land of the grantor.
