OnX Hunt Use Instruction Highlights

When you have the OnX Hunt app on your phone, and have chosen Oregon for the state map, please let me know. I will then text you the OnX maps and road tracks to whichever of my properties you are going to tour. Open each of the OnX items one at a time, and **SAVE** each one before you open another one. To download a 5-mile-wide *High-Res map* that has my colored-boundary properties inside it, get in *strong Wi-Fi*. Then use your thumb and forefinger to zoom, unzoom, and drag the map around until you have the particular property relatively centered on your screen. Then zoom out to approximately seven or 8 miles wide.

Once you have my property centered on your screen, click Offline Maps at the bottom, then New Map, then 5 Miles Wide. Verify that the property is still showing somewhere near the middle of the screen, and click Save. Let it download for a few minutes until it says "Saved Offline Maps," and click Off-Grid again. You should see a 5 mile wide green square outlining the area you downloaded. Verify that my property is inside it. You're done, and ready to go tour my beautiful properties.

Note that when you're on my properties you are the **blue dot** on the map.

USER TRICK No. 1: When you're on my properties, as you move around the blue dot may get lost off screen. Just click on the middle of the lower three round circles in the lower right, and the blue dot (your location) will re-center on the screen. (Ignore the top, fourth, circle that will either be all white or it might say "2D").

USER TRICK No. 2: Tapping that same middle circle again will create a blue "fan" off of the blue dot. Holding your phone horizontally, that <u>fan will be pointing at whatever direction you are pointing your phone</u>. Very cool tool to orient yourself. Tap the same circle again to return back to the simple blue dot.

USER TRICK No. 3: The OnX map has three versions. The first version is aerial photo (red "Sat"). The second is aerial photo with topo lines (white "Hyb"). The third is just topo lines (Blue "Topo"). You can toggle through them by touching the highest round circle of the three circles in the lower right. It should be red when you first touch it, because it starts with satellite aerial photo "Sat" as the default.

USER TRICK No. 4: When you drive close to the property and start using OnX Hunt, click Offline Maps and then click Go Offline. That will make the app use your saved map rather than trying to use a poor or no cell connection to the Internet, and it will save battery. You should also put your phone into AIRPLANE MODE to save battery and plug your phone into your car charger whenever it's convenient.
