Directions: From the intersection of Cabinet Shop Road and I-74, take Cabinet Shop Road south for 1.13 miles to Elrod Road. Turn right on Elrod Road and drive .25 miles to O'Quinn Road. Turn left on O'Quinn Road and drive 2.85 miles. The property is on the left.

Robeson County is the home of the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. Lumberton is the county seat and offers shopping, dining and a hospital. No deed restrictions.
