Location: Robeson County, Mt. Tabor Road, Red Springs, NC 28340 34.805813 -79.158191

Directions: From the intersection of McArthur Street and Highway 211 in Red Springs, take McArthur Street for .17 miles to Mt. Tabor Road. Turn right on Mt. Tabor Road and drive .78 miles. The access easement is on the left.

Deer, turkeys, and small game can be hunted on the property. You can set up a camp site and build a shooting range and ATV trails. The Lumber River is nearby for duck hunting, kayaking, canoeing, and excellent freshwater fishing for largemouth bass and panfish. The Lumber River is a nationally designated Wild and Scenic River. The primary soil type is Wagram. Robeson County is the home of the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. Lumberton is the county seat and offers shopping, dining and a hospital. No deed restrictions. The property is accessed by a 30' deeded easement. If you are looking for recreational or hunting land in southeastern NC take a look at this one!
