

## Field Notes for 17.000 Acres JAMES HENLEY SURVEY, A-531 Houston County, Texas

17.000 acres out of and a part of the JAMES HENLEY SURVEY, A-531, in Houston County, Texas and being a part of a called 63.51 acres tract, deeded to William Money recorded in Doc. No. 1406668 of the Official Records of Houston County, which 17.000 acres more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING on a point on or near the center line of County Road No. 4070 for the South corner of this 17.00 acres tract, being in a South West line of the original 63.51 acres tract, and being N 1 deg. 46 min. 59 sec. E, 49.07 feet from the South West corner of the original 63.51 acres tract, also being in County Road No. 4020, a ½ inch iron rod set for reference corner N 81 deg. 25 min. 32 sec. E, 20.17 feet;

THENCE with the center line of County Road No. 4020, N 14 deg. 57 min. 17 sec. W, 16.55 feet, N 21 deg. 32 min. 23 sec. W, 47.82 feet, N 27 deg. 12 min. 008 sec. W, 39.61 feet, N 30 deg. 37 min. 24 sec. 46.60 feet, N 34 deg. 19 min. 57 sec. W, 86.89 feet and N 38 deg. 17 min. 43 sec. W, 115.10 feet to a point for corner in same, same being a South West corner of this 17.00 acres tract, a ½ inch iron rod set for reference corner N 3 deg. 26 min. 53 sec. W, 45.39 feet;

THENCE N 3 deg. 26 min. 53 sec. W, 287.29 feet to a ½ inch iron rod set for corner, and N 7 deg. 43 min. 17 sec. E, 573.57 feet to a ½ inch iron rod set for corner, being the North West corner of this said 17.00 acres tract;

THENCE N 85 deg. 39 min. 25 sec. E, 543.49 feet to a ½ inch iron rod set for corner, being the North East corner of this said 17.00 acres tract;

THENCE S 8 deg. 08 min. 43 sec. E, 1118.59 feet to a ½ inch iron rod set for corner, same being the South East corner of this 17.00 acres tract;

THENCE S 81 deg. 25 min. 32 sec. W, 582.70 feet to the place of beginning and containing 17.000 acres of land more or less.
