RESTRICTIONS

- 1. All perimeter fencing must be constructed using barbed wire, mesh wire, or slick wire. Wooden fences are not permitted for exterior boundaries. High fencing is strictly prohibited.
- 2. The raising, breeding, or keeping of swine for commercial purposes is prohibited. However, swine may be permitted for educational projects associated with organizations such as 4-H, FFA, or similar programs, including show pigs.
- 3. No buildings or structures, except for fencing, may be constructed or placed within 50 feet of the property boundary lines.
- 4. Mobile homes, modular homes, manufactured homes, trailers, and doublewide mobile homes are strictly prohibited on the property.
- 5. Any residential dwelling constructed on the property must have a minimum living area of 1,600 square feet and be built on a slab foundation. [Consider increasing this square footage based on market demand and property standards.]
- 6. Subdivision of lots is not permitted.
- 7. All water wells must comply with the regulations set forth by the State of Texas.
- 8. Openly dug trash pits are strictly prohibited on the property.
- 9. The property is designated for residential and agricultural use only.
- 10. The extraction or mining of site materials is strictly prohibited.
- 11. The operation of commercial businesses on the property is not permitted.
