

Infrastructure System Overview

Storm Sewer

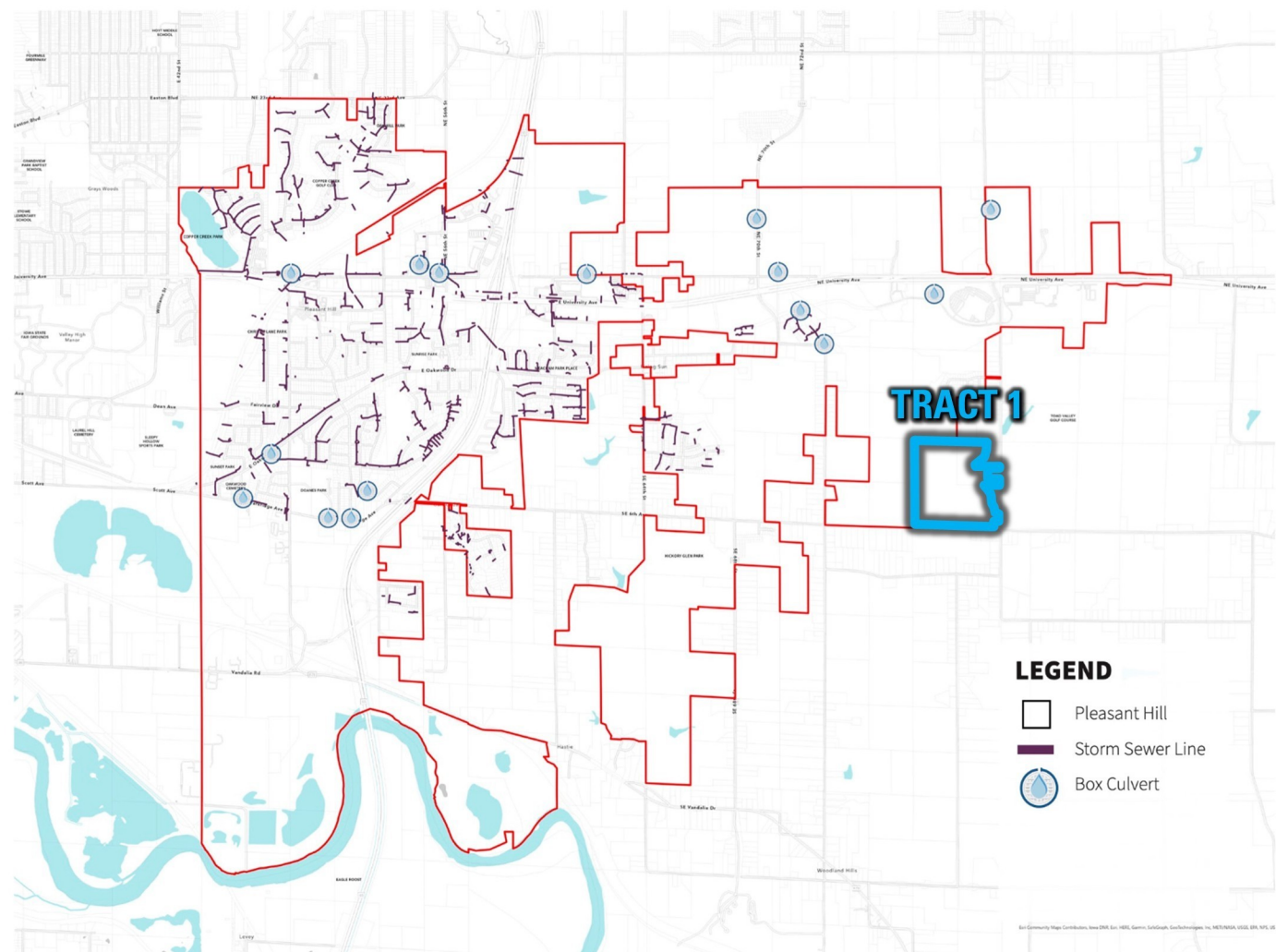


FIGURE 9.4 // EXISTING STORM SEWER SYSTEM

The City of Pleasant Hill Public Works Department oversees the storm sewer system that serves the community. The system is made up of 125 storm sewer outfalls and 950 storm sewer inlets. Figure 9.4 shows the current stormwater facilities in Pleasant Hill.

Stormwater management is provided throughout the community through on-site facilities constructed and managed with development improvement projects. The City is a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) community regulated through the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) with a permit to follow all required stormwater management practices and guidelines. Regional stormwater management opportunities are reviewed with future growth and development projects as the community continues to expand.
